We are in the process of replacing the Solemn Set of Vestments and Pall used at Funerals here at St. Paul Parish.

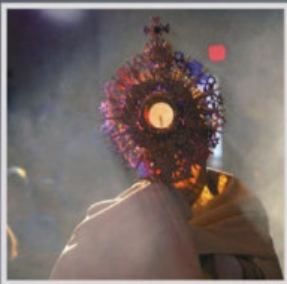

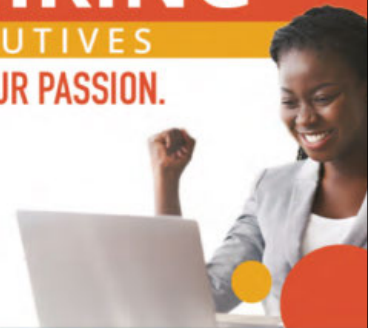
