

## EASTER

Msgr. Luigi Giussani (1922-2005) was an Italian priest and professor of theology, who spent many years teaching in Milan and who is best known as the founder of the Communion and Liberation movement. When he died in 2005, Joseph Cardinal Ratzinger (the future Pope Benedict XVI) preached his funeral Mass, saying: “[Msgr. Giussani] understood that Christianity is not an intellectual system, a packet of dogmas, a moralism; Christianity is rather an encounter, a love story; it is an event.” This approach to the Faith is apparent in a meditation that Giussani gave on the great feast of Easter that we celebrate this weekend. He writes: “Ultimately, people—young and not so young—need one thing: the certainty of the positivity of their time and of their lives, the certainty of their destiny.” He points to the resurrection of Christ on Easter Sunday as that which definitively fulfills this basic human need. “To say ‘Christ is risen’ is to affirm that reality is positive; it is to lovingly affirm reality. Without Christ’s Resurrection, there is only one possibility: nothingness.”

What we proclaim to the world this Easter is the message of hope that the Church has been proclaiming for almost 2000 years, since that Sunday morning when the disciples of Christ arrived at the empty tomb of Him who was crucified, and then encountered Him alive in the flesh. It is not a myth, but the central fact of history, that one who was dead now lives – and He shares His life with us. Reality, then, includes resurrection. Reality, then, is where we are invited into a loving relationship with God, who once died and rose again because He loves us. Reality, then, is the place of wonder, where we marvel at Him who made us, who redeems us, and who shares His life with us forever – not in some distant time or place, but right now, in the reality of the present moment. Reality thus leaves no room for despair, but is instead an open invitation to conversion and the life of high adventure, which is the life of relationship with Christ Jesus.

On behalf of Fr. Mariusz, Deacon Larry, Anh and all the staff of the Parish of St Cecilia-St. Gabriel, I wish you and your loved ones a blessed and joyful Easter. May this greatest of feasts fill your hearts with loving wonder at what God has done for us.

### Mass for Easter Sunday

**Introit:** I have arisen and I am still with you alleluia! Thou hast placed over me Thy right hand, alleluia! Wonderful hath been Thy great knowledge alleluia. Glory be to the Father, and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit, as it was in the beginning, is now and ever shall be world without end. Amen.

#### First Reading: Acts 10:34a, 37-43

Peter proceeded to speak and said: "You know what has happened all over Judea, beginning in Galilee after the baptism that John preached, how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and power. He went about doing good and healing all those oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him. We are witnesses of all that He did both in the country of the Jews and in Jerusalem. They put Him to death by hanging Him on a tree. This man God raised on the third day and granted that He be visible, not to all the people, but to us, the witnesses chosen by God in advance, who ate and drank with Him after He rose from the dead. He commissioned us to preach to the people and testify that He is the one appointed by God as judge of the living and the dead. To Him all the prophets bear witness, that everyone who believes in Him will receive forgiveness of sins through His name."

**Gradual:** This is the day which the Lord hath made; let us exult and rejoice in it. I will confess the Lord, for He is good; because His mercy is everlasting.


#### Second Reading: Col 3:1-4

Brothers and sisters: If then you were raised with Christ, seek what is above, where Christ is seated at the right hand of God. Think of what is above, not of what is on earth. For you have died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God. When Christ your life appears, then you too will appear with him in glory.

#### Gospel: Jn 20:1-9

On the first day of the week, Mary of Magdala came to the tomb early in the morning, while it was still dark, and saw the stone removed from the tomb. So she ran and went to Simon Peter and to the other disciple whom Jesus loved, and told them, "They have taken the Lord from the tomb, and we don't know where they put him." So Peter and the other disciple went out and came to the tomb. They both ran, but the other disciple ran faster than Peter and arrived at the tomb first; he bent down and saw the burial cloths there, but did not go in. When Simon Peter arrived after him, he went into the tomb and saw the burial cloths there, and the cloth that had covered his head, not with the burial cloths but rolled up in a separate place. Then the other disciple also went in, the one who had arrived at the tomb first, and he saw and believed. For they did not yet understand the Scripture that He had to rise from the dead.

**Communion Antiphon:** Christ our lamb has been sacrificed, let us share in the bread of the truth.



### FACILITIES UPDATE

Many thanks to our generous parishioners who make it possible for us to keep our parish facilities in good order so that our parish will be a safe and inviting place for people to gather for worship and fellowship for years to come.

This past week we made needed repairs to the gutter system of the Parish Office Building, replacing the original gutters -which had several leaks - with new ones.

We are also making good progress with the renovation of the parish rectory building. The demolition work revealed some long-hidden vestiges of the past, including effects of the fire that broke out in the house in the 1960s, and a fireplace buried behind the wall in the old parish office.




