TEMPERATURES & CONTACT TRACING

A few weeks ago, we were able to stop taking the temperatures of all who enter our Church and we are not checking people in for contact tracing. Temperatures will be taken for our Clergy, volunteer Ushers, Lectors and Extraordinary Ministers of Communion only. Now that we have been out of the red zone for several weeks, we feel comfortable dropping these preventative measures. We thank you for your cooperation all these many months.
