My dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

Since 1969, the Catholic Campaign for Human Development (CCHD) has addressed poverty by attacking its root causes and funding community projects that promote independence as a means of finding a permanent end to poverty. Did you know that 38.1 million Americans live below the poverty line and more than 1.5 million children experience homelessness in a year? Many of these Americans are considered "working poor"—they work but do not make enough money to cover essentials like housing, health care, child care, and food. That's why the CCHD theme is "Help Those on the Margins."

This collection is the primary source of funding for CCHD's anti-poverty grants and education programs. This year, *seventy-five percent of the collection will stay here in our diocese.* Today I am meeting with our parish and community groups which received 19 local grants from the 2020 campaign, it is always inspiring to see how these small seeds grow into fruitful programs to support the dignity of people who find themselves most often on the margins. During this pandemic, the need has increased dramatically in the many food pantries and emergency assistance programs which receive support from our local CCHD funds.

Please help the efforts of CCHD to break the cycle of poverty. We are "working on the margins" in Central Massachusetts and across America. **Support CCHD Collection on November 20 & 21 as a response to the Fifth World Day of the Poor on November 14** as called for by our Holy Father, Pope Francis. 
FIRST READING




