# End of Year Giving to Visitation Parish



### TAX SAVINGS TIP

We would like to bring your attention to a tax planning strategy regarding Charitable Contributions. This will be particularly valuable for taxpayers who are no longer able to benefit from itemizing deductions under the new tax act. **Individual Retirement Account (IRA)** distribution rules allow for the Federal tax-free treatment of IRA distributions that are donated to charity by an IRA-owner who is age 70½ or older.

A Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) allows you to transfer up to \$100,000 per year from your IRA directly to a qualified charity. It is available to individuals who have reached Required Minimum Distribution (RMD) age (70½). Any amount processed as a QCD counts toward your RMD and reduces the taxable amount of your IRA distribution (Note that a QCD must be made directly by the IRA trustee to a charitable organization). This lowers both your adjusted gross income and taxable income, resulting in a lower overall tax liability. By excluding the IRA distribution from income, the provision provides a tax benefit to itemizers and non-itemizers, alike.
