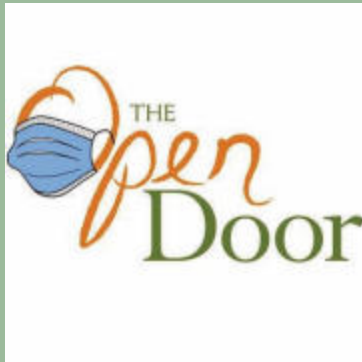
Visitation Parish Christmas 2021
