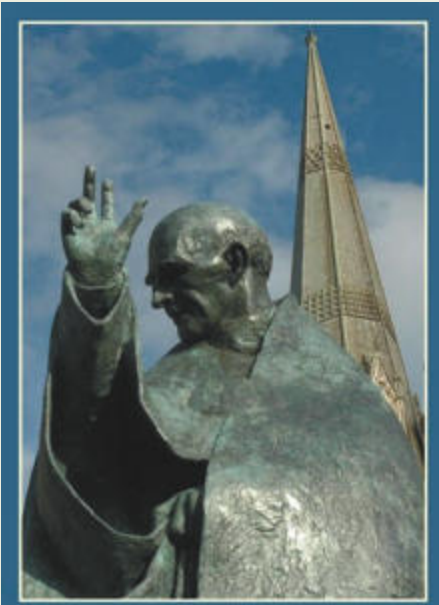

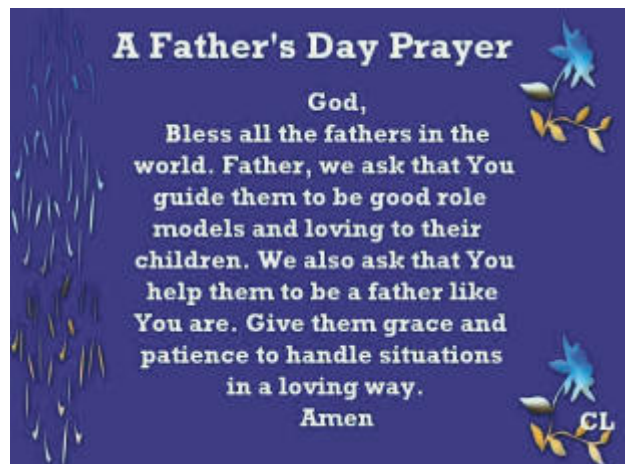
THE SAINT THOMAS MORE SOCIETY
