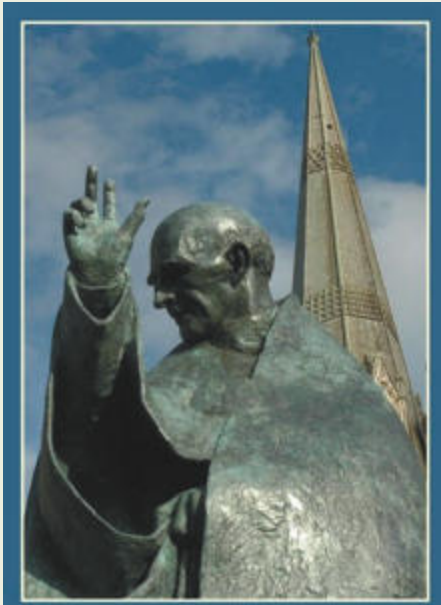

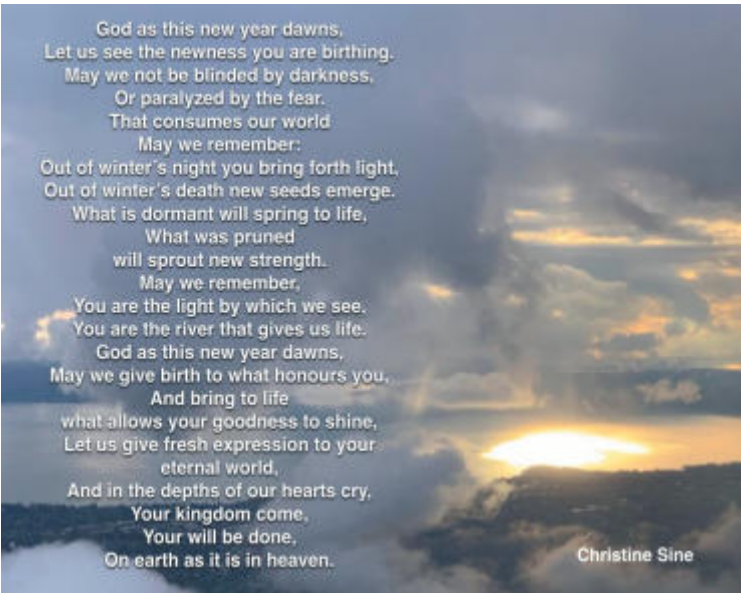
MARCH FOR LIFE
