The liturgical season of Christmas begins with the vigil Mass on Christmas Eve and concludes on the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord on January 9th. During this season, we celebrate the birth of Christ into our world and into our hearts and reflect on the gift of salvation that is born with him, including the fact that he was born to die for us.

Please note that Christmas is a Holy Day of Obligation, so attending Mass on Christmas Eve or Christmas Day fulfills your obligation for Christmas. There is *no 4:00 PM vigil Mass on Saturday, December 25th,* so we encourage you to also attend a Mass on Sunday, December 26th, to fulfill your Sunday Mass obligation.



Because the Solemnity of Mary falls on a Saturday this year (January 1st), the obligation is lifted, though we certainly encourage you to come to Mass if you are able to. We are offering the 5:00 PM Vigil on 12/31, in which we will pray for the intentions on the Angel Trees, as well as offering the daily 8:00 AM Mass on Saturday, 1/1/22, for the Solemnity of Mary Holy Day.

Adoration will end early at 3:00 PM on both Friday, December 24th and Friday, December 31st. Additionally, January 1st falls on First Saturday this year, so there <u>will not</u> be First Saturday Adoration for the month of January. There <u>will</u> be First Friday Adoration on Friday, January 7th.

ON THE SECOND DAY OF CHRISTMAS... Please join us on Sunday, December 26th, as we make a trip to LaSalette in Attleboro to see their beautiful Christmas lights display. We will meet at the parish center parking lot at 4:00 PM and plan on arriving at LaSalette by 5:00. After viewing the displays and lights, we will be heading out to a local restaurant for dinner around 7:00 (this is optional as each person is responsible for the cost of his/her food).

We are unable to provide transportation, so please plan accordingly with your family and friends to join us in the Holy Family caravan of cars heading to LaSalette!
