### FROM FR. PAWEL

On Ash Wednesday I asked you for the season of Lent to "double it up" regarding your financial commitment to the parish (almsgiving), "double it up" regarding you prayer time (prayer) and finally "double it up" your effort to fast from the vices and work on virtues (fasting). Many of us are going strong in our 40 day commitment. Some of us may have lost some steam in this spiritual battle. To both groups I would say it is always a good time to stay/come back on the spiritual wagon and fight the good fight. Let us stay motivated by the successes whether they were short or long lived. At the same time let us learn from the mistakes and in the future try to avoid those spiritual potholes.

In today's Gospel Jesus is asking for recommitment in our effort of reforming our lives. We all need the renewal of our commitments. In the next two weeks I would like to offer you two tools to reinvigorate your mind and spirit to be more productive as a person and also as the followers of Christ. Today I would like to write about prayer. Then next week I will write about our active part in this process.

What are the benefits of prayer? Why shall we spend our precious time on prayer? Is it not better to be involved in the world to do something instead of reading spiritual books, pray rosary or sit in the silence in the church? It could be the temptation to let go of prayer from our lives since this is an art that requires commitment of time and effort. But for those who invested themselves in this divine activity there is no reason to convince how beneficial prayer could be in every aspect of our lives. Sometimes we think about prayer in terms of something we must do, something painful, almost as painful but necessary as paying taxes. There is not so much pleasure or entertainment in it. Similar attitude can be sometimes displaced toward prayer. Even good Catholics may sometimes drag their feet instead of leap for joy when the time of prayer is approaching.

### FROM FR. PAWEL CONT'

It is a normal condition of the humanity in each one of us. From time to time even the greatest saints struggled in prayer. As I said before prayer is demanding of our time and effort. So why pray? We pray to worship and give thanks to God for His goodness. However, during prayer time God is giving us His gifts. What are they? Wisdom, consolation, prudence, direction, clarity, strength, perseverance. These are just some of them. Why not use prayer if it benefits us in so many ways? People invest their time and money in therapists, pills, spa, yoga. Are they more powerful than God's wisdom and guidance? What could be better than to connect and talk directly with the Highest Power? Nobody and nothing can truly give us a better deal than God Himself.

Dear brothers and sisters, wherever you are in your journey spend some time with God, talk to Him, listen to Him and the light will shine in you. You will regain your hopes and dreams. You will experience how much you are loved and forgiven. When you are committed to prayer then in every event of your life you will know what to do and say because you will be guided by the power that comes from your strong connection with Divinity.

Dear brothers and sisters now I would ask you to put into practice what you just read and start praying. Do not wait for a better opportunity, better mood or time. Now is the time. Sit still, stay silent and listen to God. Enjoy this moment. Open yourself to the silence. This silence and stillness will allow you to feel the presence of the Holy Spirit. The moment is now. Forget about the world. Forget about yourself. Focus on Him and simply just pray.






