FROM FR. PAWEL

Today we celebrate Palm Sunday. It is a joyful event but at the same time very upsetting. We see the reaction of the crowd to Jesus, which is very sympathetic, supportive, and loving. Then a few days later the same crowd will disappear in fear and those who stayed will shout out “crucified him!” Does it sound familiar dear brothers and sisters?

How many times have we experienced the same dynamic in our relationship with a person, group, or the community? From great love, like, attachment, from the words of how great we are to the words of condemnation, hatred, betrayal, or vindication. This is how our weak human nature operates. This is the danger of whom we may become if we do not tame those human tendencies with help of the Power Greater than ourselves. Only walking the spiritual path, we can resist temptation to fall into such miserable pit.

I believe here we have 2 basic lessons.

AWARENESS. First one is being aware that people are only...people. Overall, humans are weak and the betrayal, or disappointment may come any time. It always hurts but awareness and knowledge of human defects can come handy in understanding the world, people around us, their words and reactions. Also, detachment from such awareness can soften the blows.

DISATTACHMENT. Here comes the second lesson in the form of disattachment. It means a healthy emotional distance from current feelings and short perspective of thinking and reacting. It does not mean that we do not love, like or ignore the needs of others. All in all, we are all humans. Disattachment means to give up everything to God and be ready to let go of everything and everyone if God’s will is such. Complete surrender and trust in God’s Providence is our goal, and one passion we have. It does not take power of control from us, it does not turn us into emotionless robots, in contrary, it frees our spirits and humanity, it takes us to the next level of understanding, loving, and living.

EXERCISE. One of the great exercises I may suggest to help gain the distance and perspective of what is important in life is this one. Imagine you are on your deathbed. What are your thoughts, dreams, hopes and regrets? Right now, you may be going through a hard time or disappointing moments in your life. Now from the perspective of the deathbed, how do you perceive them? Are they really that important? Or rather having such an eternal perspective, you are looking at them not as problems anymore but as only minor inconvenience of life?

Such an approach does not solve the issues, nor does it deny the situation you are in. It only gives the healthy perspective and separates what is trivial and what truly matters in our lives. Then disagreement, difference of opinion or betrayal of the friend or loneliness are not troubling you as much anymore. Why? Because you gained the eternal perspective and wisdom to select and decide about what truly matters in your life and what you can let go.

God bless you in your journey.
