



BUILDING & GROUNDS



As was announced last week, many parishioners responded to our 2021 appeal to replace the parish center's heating, ventilation & air conditioning system. Please know that your generous support of St. Catherine's parish is deeply appreciated. The parish center is currently operational and is being rented by various organizations, including Ringwood's Recreation Department. The rental income helps to finance the parish debt to the diocese, the utility bills, insurance, and maintenance.

FORTUNATELY, there was some money left over from the parish center appeal - but that, **UNFORTUNATELY**, is now desperately needed to replace the roof of the school building - **along with an additional \$30,000 that must be raised**. The roof has been patched numerous times during the past 25 years and, sadly, it must now be replaced because the building has already flooded. This means we must ask you to prayerfully consider donating to this new, unavoidable project.

One of our parishioners, a professional roofer, has volunteered to oversee the roof replacement. To keep the total cost down and to prevent further flooding, we must replace the roof immediately while manpower is available and before anticipated price increases in materials. Upon completion, we will move the parish offices into the school building as well as the CCD and Confirmation classes, the Knights of Columbus meeting room, AA meetings, etc. With this overwhelming expense before us, we are initiating a Roof Replacement Fund and ask for your generous donations. Please keep in mind the words of Anne Frank that "No one has ever become poor from giving."

You will find pledge cards in the pews, as well as at the doors of the church. Online giving fund is available too. There are also census cards in the pews for people who have not already filled them out. The census information will help provide more efficient communication.

It isn't easy to ask for financial help but, truthfully, we have no other choice - as St. Catherine's is already operating on a bare-bones budget. Once again, we sincerely appreciate your loyalty, support, and generosity. **THANK YOU!**

WHY SHOULD YOU FILL OUT A CENSUS CARD?

Our records are incomplete and/or inaccurate! Over the years people have come and gone and, unfortunately, our records do not correctly reflect that. Some parishioners think that we should know them because they've "been coming here for years" but perhaps they never registered, are not actively involved, or don't use envelopes. If you aren't registered and don't use church envelopes, we probably don't know who you are or how to reach you!

Just about every week we receive inquiries from other parishes regarding people who want to be godparents for Baptism or sponsors for Confirmation. We are asked if they are "Catholics in good standing" and we cannot honestly answer that question if we don't know you.

Here are some more reasons to register:

- ◆ It gives you sense of belonging in ourparish community.
- In good times and bad, you have the support of a faith community.
- It is a commitment to practice your faith.
- Being included in the demographics of the parish helps in planning for the needs of the parish.
- It gives the parish the means to connect with you.
- In order to receive the Sacraments of Baptism, First Reconciliation, First Holy Communion, Confirmation, or Holy Matrimony you will need to be a registered member.
- For religious education instruction and Sacramental preparation, the families of those attending must also be registered parishioners.
- Lastly, to save postage costs, we plan to use email to communicate with parishioners. Our census cards now ask for your email address. (If you don't have email, please let the parish office know and we will use "snail mail" for you.)


