FROM FR. PAWEL

In today's gospel, Jesus is asking Peter three times, "do you love me?"

What would be your answer, dear brothers and sisters, if you were asked the same question? Please pause for a moment and ponder over that question. What came to your mind?

Some of us would say without hesitation "yes, I do love you!" Probably most of us would scratch our heads and say more or less "Jesus I try...I want to love you but...you know me...you know how weak and sinful I am...you know that often my love for you is feeble...often my heart is divided between loving you and the love for this world and its temptation."

Whatever is your answer to this question, let the example of Peter counsel our troubled hearts. Peter himself betrayed Christ, he left him in the time of trial, he denied him three times. Peter, from the human perspective, was a great disappointment. He did not understand Christ's teachings and miracles. He doubted in Christ several times, once even he was called by Jesus Himself "a Satan!" Again from the human perspective Peter was a disaster, embarrassment and failure. Even the moment when he walks on the water does not change his heart, he still has doubt, fears and worries.

Dear brothers and sisters, sometimes we may feel just like Peter. We may perceive ourselves in our lowest that we failed, that nobody cares or loves us. Of course we know that it is an exaggeration but emotions are emotions. They often are vocal and irrational but cannot be ignored or swept under the rug. You may feel that God calls you to a deeper relationship with Him but you are like Peter, you know your weaknesses, temptations, failings and all the spiritual misery. They may hold you back. Your heart may want to answer "I do love you Christ" but the same time you may hesitate or even get sad as Peter did when he realized how far he was from the perfection.

The tragedy happens when you stop here. When you see yourself only as the unworthy student of the Gospel but you ignore God's unconditional love for you. Peter felt unworthy too but it didn't stop Christ from loving him and entrusting him with His church. Your sins cannot stop Christ from loving you. His love is stronger than your sins and failures. Acknowledge them, repent for them but what is more important, believe that in spite of your weaknesses you are loved by God himself. Peter's faults didn't stop Christ from loving him. Why would your faults and mistakes stop Him from loving you?

As we all know, May is the Month of Mary, the mother of Jesus and our heavenly mother. Where would we all be if she hadn't said YES?

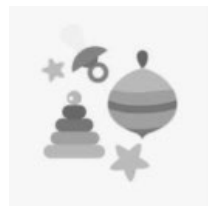
