## FROM FR. PAWEL

Today in the first reading we heard about the disciples suffering because of some people jealousy. There is nothing interesting or glamourous in being jealous. It is a serious weakness that needs to be get ridded of from the system so it will not poison the body and soul. But how one can do it? First, we need to answer ourselves if we really want to get rid of this vice or we just wish to get rid of it. So, the first step is to be honest about our intention. Otherwise if we are not truly committed to this process, we will give it up pretty soon and the untamed jealousy will spread even more. So, start with the serious commitment, "Yes! I really want to do it! I am committed!" Then attack this vice with the virtue that is 180 degrees in opposition to jealousy- Be grateful! And here are two points.

- 1. Be grateful for what you have received from God. Name it; make a list containing at least 5 things daily you are thankful for.
- 2. The second part is more challenging. Be grateful for the blessings He gave to those whom you feel jealous. For example, if you are jealous of your neighbor's house, be grateful to God first for your own house. See in your house the blessing of God, the beauty of your rooms and the grace of having a roof over your head. Stay positive and grateful. Then tell, even if you feel the serious resilience in your heart, how grateful you are for your neighbor's beautiful and specious home. Say "thank you God that you bless my brother and sister with such a gift! Thank you God! You are good to them and I am grateful to you in their behalf. Good for them Lord!" You may not feel that way but it is the intention of your heart that matters over your feelings. By repeating those words over and over you will master the art of thanksgiving and where there is positive attitude there is no room for jealousy. Just practice gratefulness and you will see the change in your spiritual perception.
- 3. Finally #3 would be to pray to God every day for the strength to not be ambushed in the web of jealousy. In your own words tell God what bothers you specifically, what kind of feelings you harbor in your heart. Then tell Him that you need His help. Be honest and direct, then when you are done with talking, stay in the silence waiting for His answer. The answer shall come in the form of calmness and clarity.

Those few steps shall help you to find God, balance your life, and realize how trivial your temporary state of jealousy is compared to the other bigger picture in life.


