## THE HUMOR AND LOVE OF SAINT JOHN XXIII

On Monday, October 11th the Church celebrates the Feast of Saint John XXIII. He was a man of great wisdom, true holiness, dry wit and tremendous love. A book called *Wit and Wisdom of Good Pope John* was published in 1964, not long after the pope's death. Who knew John XXIII was so funny? You may have already heard his famous answer to the journalist who asked innocently, "How many people work in the Vatican?" "About half of them," said His Holiness.

Another story placed Pope John in a Roman hospital called the Hospital of the Holy Spirit. Shortly after entering the building, he was introduced to the sister who ran the hospital. "Holy Father," she said, "I am the superior of the Holy Spirit." Delighted to meet her, the Pope replied "You're very lucky, I'm only the Vicar of Christ!"

These might be somewhat frivolous stories, however, for many people it was his wit that drew them to Pope John XXIII. How wonderful to keep his sense of humor, even while holding a position of such authority, when he could easily have become cold or authoritarian. How wonderful to have a sense of humor at all! Some times we forget that God, Himself gave us the gift of laughter and a sense of humor, maybe a requirement for Christian life.

Pope Saint John XXIII had a wry sense of humor, and who couldn't love a pope who had a sense of humor? Who couldn't feel affection for a man who was so comfortable with himself that he constantly made jokes about his height (which was short), his ears (which were big), and his weight (which was considerable). When he once met a little boy named Angelo, he exclaimed, "That was my name, too!" And then he said, "But then they made me change it!"

For his humor, his openness, his generosity, and his warmth, many people loved him. But to see Pope John XXIII as a sort of papal Santa Claus is to only partly understand him. An experienced diplomat, a veteran of ecumenical dialogue, and a gifted pastor and bishop, he brought a wealth of experience to the office of pope.

So maybe after you read through *Wit and Wisdom of Good Pope John* you may wish to learn more about Angelo Roncalli than just the few funny stories. I suggest you also read *Journal of a Soul* and Peter Hebblethwaite's biography *John XXIII: Pope of the Century* as a way of getting to know him better.

I have been drawn to John XXIII not as much for his wit, or his writings, or his love of the church, or even his accomplishments but for something more basic: his love for God and for other people. The gentle old man seemed to be one of the most loving of all the saints: always a loving son, a loving brother, a loving priest, a loving bishop, and a loving pope. John XXIII radiated Christian love, you may enjoy finding out more about this great man, this loving saint.
