## CONFIRMATION TO BE CELEBRATED

The Sacrament of Confirmation will be celebrated here at Immaculate Conception Parish next Sunday, October 24th, at 2:00 pm with a Mass celebrated by Most Rev. Mark O'Connell, Auxiliary Bishop of Boston. The Sacrament of Confirmation will be conferred upon 35 candidates from our Parish.

The Sacrament of Confirmation is one of Christian Initiation, along with the Sacraments of Baptism and Eucharist; it is the foundation that every Christian life is built upon. The faithful are born anew by Baptism, strengthened by the Sacrament of Confirmation, and receive the Eucharist, the food of eternal life. By means of these three Sacraments of Christian Initiation, we receive the treasure of divine life in ever-increasing measure as we continue to move toward the perfection of God's love.

Confirmation perfects baptismal grace; it is the Sacrament which gives the Holy Spirit in order to root us more deeply in God's care, incorporate us more firmly into Christ, strengthen our bond with the Church, associate us more closely with her mission, and help us bear witness to the Christian faith in words and prayers accompanied by deeds.

Sacred Scripture associates Confirmation with the Gift of the Holy Spirit and the laying on of hands. On Pentecost the apostles received the Holy Spirit whom Jesus promised to send. Confirmation provides us an

an opportunity to ratify freely and deliberately what was done for us at Baptism. It helps to focus our minds and hearts on the missionary dimensions of the baptismal commitment.

Confirmation is not a graduation, neither is it a rite of passage into Christian adulthood. This Sacrament calls us to be witnesses of the Christian faith, to live a life worthy of the calling we have received. Through Confirmation we are sealed with the Gift of the Holy Spirit and thus it strengthens us to spread and defend the faith by word and action as true witnesses of Christ, to confess the name of Christ boldly, and never to be ashamed of the cross.

Confirmation is made up of the ceremonies of anointing with oil, the laying on of hands and the words, "Be sealed with the Gift of the Holy Spirit." The oil used during celebration of Confirmation is known as Sacred Chrism, the dwelling place of the Holy Spirit, the real power of our soul.

Let us pray that we who have received the Sacrament of Confirmation may always be firm in our faith, bearing witness to the truth in all we say and do. Let us also pray for those who will be confirmed next weekend, that the Holy Spirit will enliven their hearts to be faithful Christians now and forever.

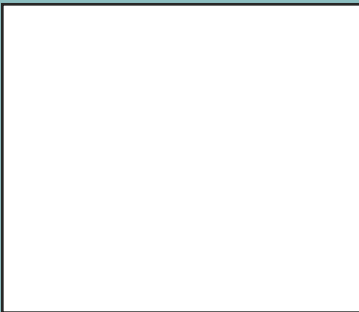
