**for a Synodal Church**  
**communion, participation, mission**

Pope Francis in his efforts to reform the Catholic Church in accordance with the teachings of the Second Vatican Council, has approved a new three-stage process for the next gathering of the synod of bishops. Its aim is to involve the whole church at diocesan, national and continental levels through a process of “listening and discernment” on the important theme of synodality: “For a synodal Church: communion, participation and mission.”

The Holy Father has decided that the synod will open in the Vatican and in every diocese throughout the Catholic world this month, October 2021. It will first go through a “diocesan phase” October 2021- April 2022 and then a “continental phase” September 2022 - March 2023 before concluding in “the universal church phase” at the Vatican with the synod of bishops in October 2023.

Since 1967, the Catholic Church has recurrently called together a Synod of Bishops. This is a time when bishops from all over the world gather in Rome to “journey together” and discuss issues in the life of the Church. In the coming months, ahead of the 2023 Synod of Bishops, Pope Francis has invited all Catholics from around the world to come together to reflect on their experiences and share input on matters of faith and the Church.

In so doing, the Church will voice our dreams, inspire hope and trust, bind up wounds, weave together relationships, and learn from one another in order to better love God and neighbor. This input from around the world will then be compiled and shared for richer discussion at the Synod of Bishops. Your involvement is greatly desired. More information on how the Church asks you personally to participate will be available in the weeks and months to come.

To mark the beginning of this synodal process in the Archdiocese of Boston, Cardinal Sean is celebrating a Mass at the Cathedral of the Holy Cross, on Saturday, November 27, at 4:30PM. The Mass will be broadcast on CatholicTV, as well being a live event.

The process begins for each one of us **now**, with the hope that as many people as possible will take a simple survey. The link to the survey can be found here:

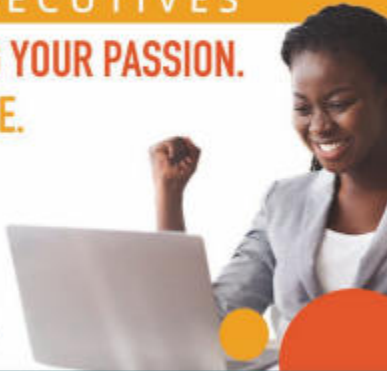
