Father Joe's Notes



My dear friends,

Merry Christmas! No, I haven't lost track of time. (Although I'm writing this in my office on December 20th!) Christmas runs through Epiphany, which we celebrate today. The season continues until the celebration of the Baptism of the Lord, which we will have next weekend. We have another week to go. It's all Christmas, so rejoice!

This year, I saw lots of buttons pronouncing "Keep Christ in Christmas!" It's a sentiment I believe in, but I think it's only half the story. I also tell people to keep the *MASS* in Christmas. It's actually the day of *Christ's Mass*, the joyous celebration of the birth of our Lord and Savior. I think that merits a proper thanksgiving to God. It's easy to remember to have the parties or even say our prayers, but do we think about our obligation to one another? We come to church to pray with each other and for each other. We bring all we are and all we do and share. We let others know they're not in this alone; we gather to unite and encourage each other on our faith journeys. When we come together, share the joy and enthusiasm with others. Greet neighbors with peace and love. That

keeps the Mass in Christmas.

I also think we need to be reminded to keep the *CHRIST* in Christian! It's easy to become stressed out and depressed at this time of year. With shorter days and all the work we've put into preparing for holidays, we can get short tempered and irritable. We might snap at the people we love and have worked so hard to make things perfect for them. Maybe we get a bit judgmental about those who are not Christians and all they're doing wrong. Perhaps we speak unkind words before we think. I know I can be prone to fail in these ways. At this time of Epiphany, where the revelation of God's love shines forth for all people to see, maybe we could recommit ourselves to sharing the light. That's how we can keep Christ in Christians.

To all of you, I hope your Christmas and Epiphany celebrations are filled with peace, love, and hope. Christ has come to us, and now we are asked to bring the Lord with us everywhere we go.

Question: Father, someone told me that if I go to a penance service, my sins are forgiven. We don't have to go to Confession. Is that correct?

Answer: No, it isn't. The only time we give general absolution is in absolute emergencies: like a plane crashing or soldiers going off to a battle. In those cases, there's risk of imminent death and no time to hear individual confession. That's the only time general absolution is used. Penance services just provide us with a way to gather as a community and pray for reconciliation: for ourselves, our community, and the world. It is a time to pray, reflect, and then go to see a confessor to seek reconciliation. Without the confession and absolution, you have not received the sacrament.

The Feast of the Epiphany

The Feast of Epiphany is not only marked by a single historical event but also by a series of events tied together by a theme. "Epiphany" means "new understanding," and the biblical stories associated with Epiphany and the season that follows share a common "aha" quality. The passages include the epiphany of the Magi who come to know the significance of the Messiah's birth, the epiphany of Jesus who embraces his baptism and his life's unique identity and mission, the epiphany of John the Baptist who identifies Jesus as the Lamb of God, and the epiphany of the first disciples who leave behind the familiar to explore the radically new. These are all significant personal events of powerful discovery, self-realization, and transformation.



This year we again invite you to mark the doorways of your home in the following way.

Please mark the doorway of your home with the initials C + M + B which come from the Latin phrase "Christus mansionem benedicat", which means "Christ bless this house", and the year 2022.

Mass Schedule Changes Effective July 1st

With the merger of parishes, the Pastoral Planning Committee of the parishes in Southington have examined our Mass attendance from October counts and looked at seating capacity of each church building. Following guidelines from the diocese that Masses should be scheduled one and half hours from the start of one Mass to the beginning of the next (allowing time for transportation), we have come up with a schedule for the new merged parish effective the Weekends of July 2nd and 3rd, 2022. 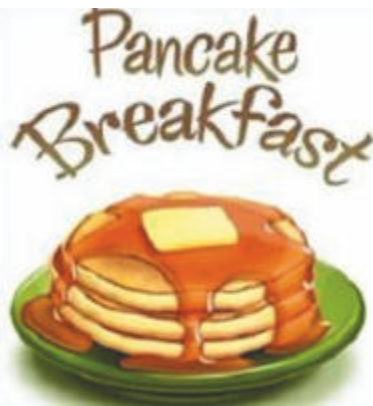
