



April is National Child Abuse Prevention Month throughout the United States. This month recognizes the importance of families and communities working together to prevent child abuse and neglect. We in the Diocese of Norwich, our parishes, schools and ministries take child protection as a top priority. We are working each day to provide safe places for our young people to learn and grow in their faith. Through the work on the NO GO TELL curriculum, conversations and support, we will continue to strive for safe environments for all our young people and vulnerable adults to have safe places and opportunities to flourish and share their faith.

Did you know....

The Catholic Church is deeply committed to protecting children from abuse and holding people accountable for inflicting such pain. In December 2021, the revised Book VI of the Code of Canon Law went into effect. This is the most recent of several documents that specifically address the issue of the abuse of children. Other documents include Vos estis lux mundi and Vademecum. These documents expand the acts which are considered abusive, clarify the manner in which the cases are processed, and hold people accountable for their action or inaction with regard to processing of a case. Of significant importance is attention given to the care of victim survivors and all who have been harmed. Bishops in the US lead the way for these changes with the implementation of the Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People 20 years ago. Today every diocese and eparchy must have in place systems for tending to those who have been harmed, protecting those in our care and seeking restorative justice.

The Fatima message from Our Lady to Sr. Lucia on December 10, 1925:

See my daughter, my Heart encircled by thorns with which ungrateful men pierce it at every moment by their blasphemies and ingratitude. Do you, at least, strive to console me. Tell them that I promise to assist at the hour of death with the Graces necessary for salvation all those who, in order to make reparation to me, on the First Saturday of five successive months go to Confession, receive Holy Communion, say five decates of the Rosary, and keep me company for a quarter of an hour, meditating on the mysteries of the Rosary.

The five 1st Saturday Devotions for reparation for insults to Our Blessed Mother's heart:

<u>FIRST:</u> Blasphemies against the Immaculate Conception

SECOND: Blasphemies against her Virginity

THIRD: Blasphemies against her Divine Maternity & denial of her Motherhood of mankind

<u>FOURTH:</u> For those who publicly seek to indoctrinate hate in the hearts of children

<u>FIFTH:</u> For those who revile her directly in her sacred images
