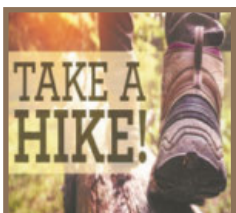

"But when he comes, the Spirit of truth, he will guide you to all truth..." (John 16:13)

It has been said that the best gift we can give someone is to teach them how to pray. If you don't talk and more importantly, listen, to God every day, how else will you know what He is calling you to do? Just as you talk to family and friends every day, get in the habit of talking with God every day. Develop a daily prayer routine. Keep your prayers simple and sincere. This is best done in silence, when you can hear His response.

St. John Paul II Faith Formation Registration for 2022 – 2023

Registration is now open for classes beginning in September. All registrations must be received by September 4, 2022.

The registration form is available on the Faith Formation website, www.sspatrickandbridgetehct.org; it can be downloaded, completed and returned to the Faith Formation Office either in person or through email or snail mail. Fees for this the grade 1-8 program are \$50 per child with a \$100 family cap; fees for the Confirmation preparation program are \$75 for Confirmation Year 1 candidates (for the 3 semesters), \$60 for Confirmation Year 2 with a cap of \$100 per family.

In order to make the best use of parish resources including catechists and facilities, respect families' busy schedules, and encourage participation in the Sunday Mass all K-8 classes will be held in the Faith Formation Building at St. Bridget Church on Sunday mornings twice per month. Classes will take place 10am – 11:30am, dismissing in time to attend the 11:30 Mass. Confirmation classes will take place 6:30pm – 8:00pm in the Faith Formation Building.

As always, families need to be registered with the St. John Paul II Parish, children entering a sacrament preparation year must have completed classes the prior year, and for any first time registrations a Baptismal certificate is required. We will host an open house in the St. Bridget Faith Formation Building on August 28, 2022 from 10am to 1pm. We will collect any last minute registrations at that time. Come say "hi" and have a look around!

WHY DO WE DO THAT? Catholic Life Explained:

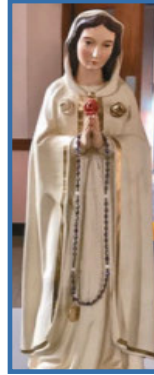
Question:

Why is the Church against stem cell research, especially if it offers the possibility of cures for diseases like Alzheimer's and Parkinson's?

Answer:

Like so many issues, the truth about stem cell research is more complicated than a few sound bites and vague promises of cures. For the Church, the problem is with embryonic stem cell research, not the research itself. The destruction of human life, even for a seemingly noble cause, is never acceptable. The ends cannot justify the means. Stem cells can be obtained in other ways, including from the placenta as well as from adults. So research is possible without the destruction of other life.

On the other hand, stem cell research shows much promise, but no concrete results. Some scientists also dispute what diseases might be cured by new discoveries. The research is still in its early stages. The question for our country is whether we should invest a lot of money in research now, looking for cures that will probably remain out of reach for most people, or should we invest that money in other programs with more immediate benefits, especially those that stress prevention and education. It is indeed a complex issue that requires close scrutiny and investigation before we jump to inaccurate conclusions or make decisions based on good, but misinformed, intentions.
