Creation Care Tips

“So out of the ground the Lord God formed every beast of the field and every bird of the air, and brought them to the man to see what he would call them; and whatever the man called every living creature, that was its name.” –Genesis 2:19. Many animals are endangered: tigers, giant pandas, and honey bees, to name a few. Honey bees are essential to our ecosystem as they are responsible for 80% of pollination, including much of the pollination required for food production. Consider different ways to help the honey bees; plan to plant native pollinators (some can even be planted in the fall for the spring), purchase honey from local beekeepers, stop using harmful pesticides, etc.

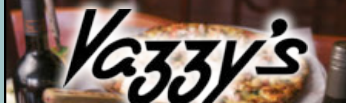
