Communion for the Homebound

IF YOU KNOW OF SOMEONE WHO IS HOMEBOUND AND WOULD LIKE TO RECEIVE THE EUCHARIST, PLEASE HAVE THEM CONTACT EITHER ONE OF OUR PARISH RECTORIES, SO THAT WE MAY ARRANGE FOR A EUCHARISTIC MINISTER TO BRING THEM COMMUNION. GOD BLESS AND THANK YOU ALL FOR BEING PART OF OUR MINISTRY OF FAITH.

Sacraments:

Baptism: Arrangements must be made in advance. Please call the Parish Office to arrange a date and supply pertinent information. Individual Baptismal preparation is required.

Sponsors: must receive from their respective Catholic pastors a "sponsor certificate," which is the signed word of one priest to another that the proposed godparent is a Confirmed, fully-practicing Catholic who is qualified to be a godparent by living in harmony with our faith.

Reconciliation: at St. Francis of Assisi on Saturdays from 3:30-3:50PM and at St. Dominic's on Sunday from 9:00AM to 9:15AM. You can also call the office and make an appointment or see the Priest after morning Mass.

First Eucharist & Confirmation: Preparation – two years prior to receiving each Sacrament is mandatory as a registered student in the Faith Formation Program.

Matrimony: Couples are asked to consult with our priest at least six months in advance of the intended date to allow time for marriage preparation, including the Diocesan Program.

Ministry to the Sick: Please notify us if someone you know is homebound and would like to be added to our Communion call list, or would like to receive the Sacrament of the Sick.

Low gluten hosts available: Please let us know before Mass if you have a need to receive this type of host.

Twenty-seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

In the Christian dispensation, when a man and woman take each other as husband and wife, it is to be a relationship that is like that of a child and a parent. There is to be total trust, total self-giving and complete confidence between a married couple, just like there is for a child in relationship with a parent. This is why marriage is not something we undertake as a whim - it requires of us a great deal. This is the same kind of union is what God offers to each of us, except a million times more intense and true.

An examination of the first reading and psalm make this clear. Woman and man are not just other ways of being that might complement each other, they are united at a level so deep that it is written in our chromosomes.

The letter to the Hebrews gives an additional dimension to this: the brotherhood of all of us with Jesus. We know that human love can communicate something of God's love for us: especially the love of husband and wife, of parent and child. What Hebrews tells us is that the sibling relationship is also a demonstration of the love of God. We cannot cease to be someone's brother or sister, no matter what. The wonder of God is the Jesus has chosen to take on this relationship and to be our brother always.




