

As always, if you are in need of help with utilities, rent or groceries, we are here to help. Call the rectory and you will be put in touch with a member who would love to assist you.

#### Sacraments:

**Baptism**: Arrangements must be made in advance. Please call the Parish Office to arrange a date and supply pertinent information. Individual Baptismal preparation is required.

**Sponsors**: must receive from their respective Catholic pastors a "sponsor certificate," which is the signed word of one priest to another that the proposed godparent is a Confirmed, fully-practicing Catholic who is qualified to be a godparent by living in harmony with our faith.

**Reconciliation:** at St. Francis of Assisi on Saturdays from 3:30-3:50PM and at St. Dominic's on Sunday from 9:00AM to 9:15AM. You can also call the office and make an appointment or see the Priest after morning Mass.

**First Eucharist & Confirmation**: Preparation – two years prior to receiving each Sacrament is mandatory as a registered student in the Faith Formation Program.

**Matrimony**: Couples are asked to consult with our priest at least six months in advance of the intended date to allow time for marriage preparation, including the Diocesan Program.

**Ministry to the Sick**: Please notify us if someone you know is homebound and would like to be added to our Communion call list, or would like to receive the Sacrament of the Sick.

**Low gluten hosts available:** Please let us know before Mass if you have a need to receive this type of host.

#### All I want for Christmas – Part Two

In last weekend's bulletin, I shared how I approached my Christmas wish list this year. Since Christmas is not just a day, but an entire season, I thought I'd share a few more thoughts about wish lists, and offer a challenge to anyone who's up for it.

As I noted last week, as I have gotten older my priorities have changed, and so has my Christmas wish list. Honestly, I wish I had more time to spend with the people that mean the most to me. I wish I worried less and trusted in God more. I wish I were more patient and less judgmental. I wish I laughed more, and loved more, and lived life more fully. Material things just don't seem to matter much to me anymore. Clearly, my Christmas wish list has become a list of intangibles.

Recently, I thought about the Church, and I wondered if anyone had created a Christmas wish list for their parish. I did a quick Internet search, and I must admit, I was a bit disappointed in the results. The wish list on any number of parish websites included things like telephones, microwaves, office equipment, sports items, musical instruments, furniture — and oh yes, money! In my brief and non-scientific research, I did not find one parish list that reached beyond the walls to address the needs of the community, the nation, or the world. Like many Christmas lists, there were a lot of tangibles, but not much in the way of a vision for the faith community. Wishing for things isn't bad in and of itself, but let's think outside of the (gift) box!

Yesterday, we celebrated the birth of Christ, and in a few short days we will welcome in the New Year – 2022! We are also beginning the first phase of the synodal process instituted by Pope Francis, which will help shape a new way for the Church to understand its ministry and mission of evangelization. With that in mind, I'd like to extend an invitation and a challenge. I invite you to make a wish list, not for yourself but for the Church. Contemplate your dreams and desires for your parish, your community, for your diocese, and for the Church both nationally and globally. Consider what changes or improvements you would like to see in the coming year or perhaps the next five or ten years. I challenge you to act on your dreams and desires for the Church and the world. And most importantly live your faith. Become the hands and feet of Christ. Go out and make a difference. Reach out to the poor and marginalized. Stand up for justice and peace. Speak up for those who have no voice. Be Christ's presence in the world. Merry Christmas!


