#### Sacraments:

Baptism: Arrangements must be made in advance. Please call the Parish Office to arrange a date and supply pertinent information. Individual Baptismal preparation is required.

**Sponsors**: must receive from their respective Catholic pastors a "sponsor certificate," which is the signed word of one priest to another that the proposed godparent is a Confirmed, fullypracticing Catholic who is qualified to be a godparent by living in harmony with our faith.

Reconciliation: at St. Francis of Assisi on Saturdays from 3:30-3:50PM and at St. Dominic's on Sunday from 9:00AM to 9:15AM. You can also call the office and make an appointment or see the Priest after morning Mass.

First Eucharist & Confirmation: Preparation – two years prior to receiving each Sacrament is mandatory as a registered student in the Faith Formation Program.

**Matrimony**: Couples are asked to consult with our priest at least six months in advance of the intended date to allow time for marriage preparation, including the Diocesan Program.

Ministry to the Sick: Please notify us if someone you know is homebound and would like to be added to our Communion call list, or would like to receive the Sacrament of the Sick.

Low gluten hosts available: Please let us know before Mass if you have a need to receive this type of host.

#### The Epiphany of The Lord

This week's readings are all about people from different cultures and tribes coming together to celebrate the Lord. In the first reading, Isaiah describes a caravan of nations gathering in the light of the Lord. In the second reading, Paul makes the case for salvation outside of the Jewish faith when he tells the Ephesians that "Gentiles are coheirs, members of the same body, and copartners in the promise in Christ Jesus through the gospel."

This is a relatively pedestrian concept for modern Catholics, but for Christians in the years after Christ's resurrection, this notion is radical. The special covenant between God and Abraham now extends to all nations, including those outside of the Hebrew faith. This isn't something Paul proposes for the first time in his letter to the Ephesians. It begins the week Jesus is born, when the leaders of nations with no ethnic relation to Israel come and pay a tiny Hebrew boy homage.

We are often caught up in how our faith affects (and is affected by) the culture and politics of the country where we live. This week's readings give us an opportunity to reflect on the international aspect of salvation. Catholics have a tendency to "get into the weeds" when it comes to living the gospel. This week, we have an opportunity to take in a much wider view of our church and celebrate the universality of Christ's message.


