



There will be a celebration of the Feast Day of the Holy Child of Cebu on Saturday, January 16<sup>th</sup> at our 5:30 p.m. Mass. Seating is limited. 

## Reflecciones del Parroco

### Gifts of New Birth

Epiphany is a celebration of the adoration of magi from the East who sought and found Christ the newborn king. Their gift of gold honored Jesus as king. Their gift of incense honored Jesus as God. And their gift of myrrh honored the gift that Jesus would eventually give to us: his death. He was born to sacrifice his life for us. He took to the cross our sins, and then his resurrection destroyed the power of sin and the power of demons who tempt us to sin. The gifts of the magi become gifts that we all give to Jesus: Gold represents our righteousness, which Christ's kingship over our lives makes possible so that we become more and more saintly each day. Incense represents our prayers going up to God - prayers that involve giving God the gift of our trust. And myrrh is the gift of suffering for Christ: the sacrifices we make for the sake of his ongoing mission of transforming our world. The word "epiphany" means a moment of discovery, a revelation that changes our lives. Did the magi have an epiphany about Jesus when they came into his presence? Did they realize that they were looking at the Savior of the world? Did they want this little baby to save them from their own sins? We can safely assume that they never forgot about their trip to Bethlehem. Surely they kept their ears open for news about him as the years went by. Probably they heard about the King of the Jews who was crucified. We know that they in fact became very saintly Christians; their relics still exist and have been venerated since very early times. What about you and me? Will we remember Jesus in some new way this year? Will our worship of him transform us? Will the power of sin be defeated by our faith in Christ when we face temptations? ### Dones del nuevo nacimiento

La Epifanía es una celebración de la adoración de los reyes magos del Este, que buscaron y encontraron a Cristo, el rey recién nacido. Al regalar oro honraban a Jesús como rey. Al regalar incienso honraban a Jesús como Dios. Y con su ofrenda de mirra honraban el regalo que Jesús nos daría eventualmente: Su muerte. Él nació para sacrificar Su vida por nosotros. Llevó nuestros pecados a la cruz, y luego Su resurrección destruyó el poder del pecado y el poder de los demonios que nos tientan a pecar. Los regalos de los reyes magos se convierten en regalos que todos damos a Jesús: el oro representa nuestra justicia, la cual es posible por el reinado de Cristo sobre nuestras vidas, de modo que seamos cada día más santos. El incienso representa nuestras oraciones que se elevan a Dios – oraciones que involucran dar a Dios el regalo de nuestra confianza. Y la mirra es el regalo del sufrimiento por Cristo: los sacrificios que hacemos por el bien de Su continua misión de transformar nuestro mundo. La palabra "epifanía" implica un momento de descubrimiento, una revelación que cambia nuestras vidas. ¿Tuvieron los reyes magos una epifanía sobre Jesús cuando estuvieron en Su presencia? ¿Eran conscientes que estaban viendo al Salvador del mundo? ¿Querían ellos que este pequeño bebé les salvara de sus propios pecados? Podemos presumir con seguridad que ellos nunca se olvidaron de este viaje a Belén. Seguramente estuvieron atentos a las noticias sobre Él con el pasar de los años. Probablemente oyeron sobre el Rey de los Judíos que fue crucificado. Sabemos que de hecho se convirtieron en Cristianos muy santos; sus reliquias todavía existen y han sido veneradas desde los primeros siglos. ¿Y qué hay de ti y de mí? ¿Recordaremos a Jesús de alguna manera nueva este año? ¿Nos transformará nuestra adoración a Él? ¿Será derrotado el poder del pecado por nuestra fe en Cristo cuando enfrentemos las tentaciones? ## Gospel Meditation

Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture  
Epiphany of the Lord

“Where is that thing?” mumbled Bob as he searched frantically on his dimly lit desk for the current electric bill. “I know I put it right on top of these papers this morning!” Growing in frustration and bordering on anger, he flies stuff around, moves books and opines why simple tasks need to be so hard. Enter his wife, who calmly says, “Maybe it would help if you put the light on, dear.” The desk light goes on and lo and behold, there is the electric bill right where Bob left it earlier. All it took was a little light!

We stubbornly refuse to turn on the lights! Either we are distracted, determined, disinterested, preoccupied, stubborn, apprehensive, or all of the above. Or perhaps, we fail to do the obvious. We would rather live our lives with the dimmest of lights or even in total darkness. Why are we afraid to do something so that we can actually see? It might help us to find quicker and better answers to problems, the meaning of life, relationships, happiness, and what is ultimate truth. Yet, we stumble along, moving things from one side to the other, getting angry, feeling cheated, being unsettled, resigning ourselves to the agony of defeat once again.

“And behold, the star that they had seen at its rising preceded them, until it came and stopped over the place where the child was.” The light has come into the world in the person of Jesus Christ! We no longer have to fumble in the darkness. We have been gifted with the illumination we need to see our way through things and find what we really are looking for. All these years later, however, so many are still reluctant to accept him. Perhaps they are unconvinced, disinterested, preoccupied, stubborn, apprehensive, or all of the above. Everyone has their own reason for not wanting to turn on the switch.

But there are so many answers to so many of our problems in this humble Child of Nazareth. A simple birth teaches us about God’s tender wedded relationship with humanity. It speaks to the expanse of God’s salvation across the globe, and the incarnate Divine wonders and blessings that are a part of our life moment to moment. It calls us to understand the design of world order God intended as found in the Beatitudes, the sacredness of every human life and all of creation and the meaning of things we struggle with most, like suffering and death. We have a lot of Good News to share, not just with a privileged few but with all the world. All races and creeds can receive God’s healing word. God continues to manifest himself even now! ## A Gift of Life

The Knights of Columbus are undertaking a project with the goal of obtaining an ultrasound machine for the Eastern Shore Pregnancy Center in Salisbury. The Center has been in service since 1982 and provides support to anyone facing the challenges of a crisis or unintended pregnancy. The ultrasound (which the K of C donated 7 years ago) is still in service in the pregnancy center but is in need of replacement.

The Center has recently obtained an RV and the funding to renovate it in order that they can go on the road to underserved areas on the shore. They are planning to be able to schedule pregnancy testing and sonograms. They hope to be able to offer these services to individuals who cannot come to Salisbury to the ESPC. They need an ultrasound that can be mobile to do this.

Statistically, if a mother sees her baby and hears the heartbeat, she is more likely to choose Life. There is an opportunity to have our funds matched with the Knights of Columbus ultrasound program to make this happen. Your donations will support the culture of Life in our community.
