

## Reflecciones del Parroco

### Awaken the fullness of life in the Holy Spirit

The Holy Spirit is Christ's Spirit generously given to us so that we can be holy and continue the ministry that Christ began. On our own, we cannot be like Jesus, but if his Spirit is alive and active within us, we have Christ's holiness, his faith, his supernatural love and peace, confidence and endurance, and everything else that we see in Jesus. You received the Holy Spirit during your baptism. The reality of this was confirmed and strengthened in the Sacrament of Confirmation. Ever since the first out-pouring of the Spirit on Pentecost, God has been transforming the world by working through those who serve his Kingdom. He generously fills us with his Spirit so that we will succeed at whatever he asks us to do. But how well his holiness and power exude from us is up to us. Dear Jesus, stir up within me the fullness of Your Holy Spirit. Help me to live in Your holy power. Open my mind to understand Your truths and open my heart to accept Your truths even before I gain right understanding. O Holy Spirit, help me to seek, more than anything, the kingdom of God. ### Catholic Vs. Protestant Bibles

Question: Why are Catholic and Protestant Bibles different?

Answer: Since the earliest days of the Church, Christians used a Greek translation of the Old Testament known as the Septuagint. This collection of the texts of the Hebrew Scriptures included 46 books. At the time of the Protestant Reformation in the 1500s, the Protestant reformers began to create their own translations of the Bible (into local languages) and some began to question why the Jewish Scriptures would have included texts that were written in Greek, because, they assumed, the only valid Jewish Scriptures would have been written in Hebrew. And so, they decided to remove seven books from the Old Testament: Baruch, Sirach, 1 and 2 Maccabees, Tobit, Judith and Wisdom (as well as portions of the Books of Daniel and Esther). This means that the Protestant Old Testament only includes 39 books, while Catholic Bibles continue to include those original 46 books. Both Catholic and Protestant Bibles include 27 books and letters in the New Testament.

### Thoughts from the Principal

One of my goals as principal of St. Francis de Sales Catholic School has been to propel our technology resources to a level that would promote twenty-first century skills in our students. These vital attributes include collaboration, problem solving, communication, creativity and critical thinking. The most important outcome of reaching this goal is graduating digital leaders from our eighth grade class who transition successfully to high school and beyond.

We offer a multi-disciplinary, project-based approach to instruction called STREAMS. This is our unique acronym for science, technology, religion, engineering, arts, mathematics and Spanish. During any given lesson, students are exposed to two or more of these subject areas. For example, students in an eighth grade algebra class may launch a rocket. Facets of this may include drawing the design, building the rocket, discussing physics topics like gravity, and collecting data in order to make the algebraic expression of a parabola come to life.


A unit in first grade about penguins may include walking around the room like a penguin, creating a model of a penguin habitat, examining global warming effects on the penguin's environment and writing a story from a penguin's point of view. Joining several subjects in a lesson has research-based benefits and clearly makes learning more fun! Educators know that the integration of a variety of subjects ensures that we are targeting different learning styles.

The original STEM programs began a great trend in education. When students use more than one discipline to learn, their brains make better connections that enhance retention and recall of content and skills. Recently educators have realized that it's not only the math and science related fields that can benefit. The addition of the humanities enhances the traditional STEM programs bringing in creativity and a different area of the brain. When we incorporate the arts, language and religion students learn an appreciation for human society, ideologies and beliefs. Educators are challenged to teach students to be creative problem solvers capable of collaborating using world class skills.

We are a 1:1 school for grades K-8. We are grateful to our Home and School Association, parish and the Richard A. Henson Foundation for the financial support that enabled us to offer all students in grades two through eight their own Chromebook for home use. We are a Google Classroom school with a teacher, Mary-Tyler Upshaw, who is a certified Google Classroom administrator and coach. Our faculty, student body and families continue to work together as partners in education.

Our school community is motivated by cultivating the four tenets that are the basis of our school culture and our school mission. These are scholarship, faith, dignity and service. This year we have worked hard to have in person learning since September. Parents send their children to St. Francis de Sales Catholic School for a safe environment and a well-rounded educational program. We are happy to report that our enrollment is the highest it has been in more than ten years. Many classes are at capacity. We still have openings in a few levels. 


## KNIGHTWATCH!

“Breathes there a man, with soul so dead, who never to himself hath said, ‘This is my own, my native land!’” Verse penned by Sir Walter Scott, words which have echoed down the years, especially when patriotism and love of country are as much in the national conscience as on occasions such as upcoming Memorial Day. Poets have an amazing ability to express in very few words the most profound and evocative truths. Joyce Kilmer, the soldier poet who gave *his* life on the field of battle in France in 1918, brought all nature into perspective, writing: “I think that I shall never see a poem lovely as a tree . . . that looks at God all day, and lifts her leafy arms to pray.” Kilmer, Catholic, and member of The Knights of Columbus, wrote of the Rosary: “There is one song that any mouth can say, a song that lingers when all singing dies. When, on their beads, our Mother’s children pray, immortal music charms the grateful skies.”
