




Using IRA Distributions for Charity

An increasingly popular way to transfer IRA assets to charity is via a tax provision which allows IRA owners who are 70½ or older to direct up to \$100,000 per year of their IRA distributions to charity. These distributions are known as qualified charitable distributions, or QCDs. The money given to charity counts toward the donor's required minimum distribution (RMD), but doesn't increase the donor's adjusted gross income or generate a tax bill.

Keeping the donation out of the donor's AGI (annual gross income) is important because doing so can (1) help the donor qualify for other tax breaks (for example, having a lower AGI can reduce the threshold for deducting medical expenses, which are only deductible when they exceed 10% of AGI); (2) reduce taxes on the donor's Social Security benefits; and/or (3) help the donor avoid a high-income surcharge for Medicare Part B and Part D premiums (which kick in if AGI is over certain levels).

Further, because charitable contributions will not yield a tax benefit for those taxpayers who no longer itemize their deductions (thanks to the larger standard deduction for 2018 and thereafter), those who are age 70½ or older and are receiving RMDs from IRAs, may gain a tax advantage by making annual charitable contributions by way of a QCD from an IRA. This charitable contribution will reduce RMDs by a commensurate amount, and the amount of the reduction will be tax-free.

The Power of the Eucharist

This Sunday's readings speak to us of the Eucharist: 'the blood of the covenant' and 'the cup of salvation'. What does the Eucharist mean to you? Christ came to earth to serve us as our high priest. Unlike the Jewish priests of the Old Testament, who atoned for the people's sins with the blood of goats and calves, Jesus absolved our sins with his own blood. He said: "This is my blood of the covenant, shed for many." This is the *new* covenant. With it he achieved what no other high priest could do: He obtained for us eternal redemption. Only the blood of God himself could accomplish this, because no matter how good our intentions are, and no matter how holy a priest might be, we all fall back into sin again and again. Only Jesus, the perfectly holy human whose divinity conquered death, could open the doors to eternal life. Jesus paid a very high price to atone for our sins. What if we come to Mass with un-repentant sins? We know we've done wrong, yet our desire to avoid the hard work and humility of changing is larger than our desire to let Jesus transform us. It's larger than our desire to enjoy all the benefits of the Eucharist. To receive his body and blood in the Eucharist without letting it atone for our sins is to snub and reject the terrible price that Jesus paid when he died for us. To avoid his presence in the Sacrament of Confession because it makes us feel uncomfortable is highly disrespectful of the suffering that he endured for us. If we accept the on-going atonement provided for us in the Eucharist without accepting the need to repent of any sin, we are insulting Jesus while denying ourselves an opportunity to let him save us from that sin. The Most Holy Body and Blood of Jesus Christ have the power to "transubstantiate" us into his likeness. We should always leave Mass different than when we arrived. This is God's plan! El Poder de la Eucaristía

Las lecturas de este domingo nos dicen de la Eucaristía: "la sangre de la alianza" y "la copa de la salvación". ¿Qué significa la Eucaristía para ti? Cristo vino a la tierra a servirnos como nuestro sumo sacerdote. Diferente de los sacerdotes judíos del Antiguo Testamento, que expiaban los pecados de la gente con la sangre de las cabras y becerros, Jesús perdonó nuestros pecados con su propia sangre. Él dijo: "Esta es mi sangre de la alianza derramada por muchos." Esta es la *nueva* alianza. Con ella logró lo que ningún otro sacerdote pudo hacer: obtuvo la redención eterna para nosotros. Sólo la sangre del mismo Dios pudo lograr esto, porque, más allá de cuán buenas sean nuestras intenciones y más allá de cuán santo pueda ser un sacerdote, todos caemos nuevamente en pecado una y otra vez. Sólo Jesús, el hombre perfectamente santo cuya divinidad conquistó la muerte, pudo abrir las puertas a la vida eterna. Jesús pagó un precio muy alto por la expiación de nuestros pecados. ¿Qué pasa si vamos a Misa sin arrepentirnos de nuestros pecados? Sabemos que hemos hecho mal, sin embargo, nuestro deseo de evitar el duro trabajo y la humillación de cambiar, es mayor que nuestro deseo de dejar que Jesús nos transforme. Es mayor que nuestro deseo de disfrutar de todos los beneficios de la Eucaristía. Recibir su cuerpo y sangre en la Eucaristía sin permitirle que expie nuestros pecados, es despreciar y rechazar el precio terrible que pagó Jesús cuando murió por nosotros. Evitar su presencia en el Sacramento de la Confesión porque nos hace sentir incómodos, es altamente irrespetuoso hacia el sufrimiento que soportó por nosotros. Si aceptamos la constante expiación que nos es dada en la Eucaristía, sin aceptar la necesidad de arrepentirnos de ningún pecado, estamos insultando a Jesús mientras nos negamos a nosotros mismos la oportunidad de permitirle que nos salve de ese pecado. El Santísimo Cuerpo y Sangre de Jesucristo tiene el poder de "transubstanciarlos" en Él. Siempre deberíamos irnos de Misa diferente a cómo llegamos. ¡Este es el plan de Dios! Patron Saints

Question: Why are some saints honored as "patron saints"?

Answer: Each person is unique and each of us has different gifts, interests, talents, and, yes, even struggles and areas where we need to grow. This is no less true of those holy women, men, and children who have been canonized or beatified. Because we believe that the saints and blessed are both models of faith and intercessors, Christians have looked to certain holy people as role models and heavenly protectors for occupations, spiritual charisms, and even places. Although the Church sometimes names a person as a patron saint (e.g. Saint Philip Neri as the patron of Rome, Saint Clare of Assisi as the patroness of television, or Saint Aloysius Gonzaga as the patron of youth and young adults), more often it is popular devotion that inspires lay Christians to turn to a particular saint or blessed for heavenly help and support. This is how, for example, Saint Cecilia came to be honored as the patroness of musicians, Saint Toribio Romo as patron of migrants coming into the United States, and Saint Gertrude of Nivelles as patroness of cat lovers. Although there are official and unofficial lists of patron saints, we should always feel free to ask any and all the saints to give us their patronage and protection in whatever it is that we need. ©LPi



KNIGHTWATCH!

J. Edgar Hoover, the egotistical but infamously thin-skinned Director of the F.B.I from 1924 to 1972, whenever an extremely challenging and difficult case arose, would growl "Get me Sullivan!" and agent Joseph A. Sullivan would respond. Ironically, Sullivan's characteristically successful pursuit of such cases often incurred the jealousy of Hoover, who on one occasion "promoted" his invaluable employee by moving him from the New York bureau to a field office in Anchorage, Alaska! It was not long before, when another challenging case arose, the order to "Get me Sullivan!" was again issued, and he was back – as Major Case Inspector – and assigned to a number of Klan-related cases in the Deep South. Perhaps the most noteworthy of these, mostly Civil Rights investigations, was his solving of the tragic June 1964 triple-murder case which was the fictionalized basis of the movie "Mississippi Burning". Joe Sullivan was very proud of his F.B.I. service to our country. And also of his lifelong membership in, and service to, another organization, The Knights of Columbus.
