

# A people of prayer...



You are invited to join us for an afternoon of prayer on Divine Mercy this Sunday, April 24<sup>th</sup>. Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament for adoration will begin at 2:00 p.m. in the St. Francis de Sales Church. A sung chaplet of Divine Mercy will begin at 3:00 p.m. followed by Benediction.

This Sunday, the second Sunday of Easter, since 2000 has been called the Sunday of Divine Mercy. St. Faustina's Diary records 14 occasions when Jesus requested that a Feast of Mercy (Divine Mercy Sunday) be observed, for example:

*My daughter, tell the whole world about My inconceivable mercy. I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the Fount of My mercy. The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. ... Let no soul fear to draw near to Me. ... It is My desire that it be solemnly celebrated on the first Sunday after Easter. Mankind will not have peace until it turns to the Fount of My Mercy. (Diary, no. 699)*

On May 5<sup>th</sup>, 2000, five days after the canonization of St. Faustina, the Vatican decreed that the Second Sunday of Easter would henceforth be known as Divine Mercy Sunday. The world is in great need of kindness and mercy. Today would be a great day to learn how to pray the Chaplet of Divine Mercy for one another and the world. ## Pastor's Ponderings

## Reflecciones del Parroco

### Alive in the Spirit of Mercy

This Sunday's Gospel reading sets the stage for Pentecost. Prior to giving us the full gift of his Spirit, Jesus provides the gift of peace, the gift of his heart. A supernatural gift, it penetrates deep into our own hearts. It is the calming presence of Christ when we face challenges and difficulties. Jesus bestowed it upon his first apostles twice in the same meeting shortly after his resurrection. Then he gave them the life-breath of God, the Holy Spirit, and commissioned them with the priesthood of forgiving the sins of others -- another gift that brings peace. This gift of peace has been distributed by Jesus ever since, through the ordained priesthood in what we now call the Sacrament of Reconciliation. And to hold us steady in our efforts to remain holy, Jesus still gives us the breath of God. This breath, this life-sustaining presence of God's Spirit, which created the world and which keeps us spiritually alive, is the Holy Spirit -- God's holiness activating us and dwelling within us.

Whatever is not holy -- not of the Spirit -- is sinful and destructive. Jesus, who is the embodiment of Divine Mercy, died on the cross and gave us his Spirit so that we could live in the forgiveness of God.

Whenever you pray the "Our Father", do it slowly and intentionally, and pay attention to these words: "Forgive us our sins as we forgive those who sin against us." Think of the people who have irritated you the most or who have continued to behave hurtfully without remorse. Consciously forgive them during this prayer.

Otherwise, your unforgiveness could affect their eternal souls as well as your own, because you're denying them an opportunity to understand God's forgiveness through your example, and you're denying God the opportunity to forgive you for your sin of unforgiveness.

Forgiveness doesn't mean approving of the sin nor forgetting what was done. It means letting go of the desire to retaliate. It means choosing to love whether it's deserved or not. ### Vivo en el Espíritu de Misericordia

La lectura del Evangelio de este domingo prepara el escenario para Pentecostés. Antes de darnos el regalo completo de su Espíritu, Jesús ofrece el don de la paz, el don de su corazón. Un don sobrenatural, que penetra profundamente en nuestros propios corazones. Es la apacible presencia de Cristo cuando nos enfrentamos a desafíos y dificultades. Jesús se lo confiere dos veces a sus primeros apóstoles en la misma reunión, poco después de su resurrección. Luego les dio el aliento vital de Dios, el Espíritu Santo, y les encomendó el sacerdocio de perdonar los pecados de los demás -- otro regalo que nos trae paz. Este don de la paz ha sido distribuido por Jesús desde entonces, a través del sacerdocio ordenado, en lo que ahora llamamos el Sacramento de la Reconciliación y para mantenernos constantes en nuestros esfuerzos para la santidad, Jesús nos da el aliento de Dios. Este aliento, esta presencia del Espíritu de Dios, que sostiene la vida, que creó el mundo y que nos mantiene espiritualmente vivos, es el Espíritu Santo - la santidad de Dios activándonos y habitando en nosotros. Lo que no es santo -- que no proviene del Espíritu -- es pecaminoso y destructivo. Jesús, que es la encarnación de la Divina Misericordia, murió en la cruz y nos dio su Espíritu para que pudiéramos vivir en el perdón de Dios. Cada vez que rezas el "Padre Nuestro", hazlo lenta y deliberadamente y presta atención a estas palabras: "Perdona nuestras ofensas como también nosotros perdonamos a los que nos ofenden". Piensa en las personas que te han irritado o que se comportan hirientes contigo y no sienten ningún remordimiento. Perdónalos conscientemente durante esta oración. De lo contrario, tu falta de perdón podría afectar sus almas eternas, así como la tuya, porque les estás negando la oportunidad de entender el perdón de Dios a través de tu ejemplo, y estás negando a Dios la oportunidad que te perdona por tu pecado de falta de perdón. El perdón no significa aprobar el pecado ni olvidar lo que se hizo, significa dejar de lado el deseo de tomar represalias, significa elegir amar sin importar si es merecido o no, es entrar de nuevo en el regalo de la paz de Cristo. @2020 Terry Modica, Catholic Digital Resources, www.catholicdr.com.







Within the Book of the Prophet Isaiah we encounter four poetic sections known as the Songs of the Suffering Servant. The specific identity of this *Servant of the Lord* remains the topic of scholarly debate. Perhaps it refers to the prophet Isaiah himself, perhaps the entire nation of Israel, or possibly the promised Messiah. Christian faith sees these prophetic utterances fulfilled in the life, ministry, death, and resurrection of Jesus the Lord.

Each year the Eastern Shore Literacy Association (ESLA) holds its Young Authors' Contest. Finalists are individuals who have finished in the top three in their respective category, poetry or short story, and grade level. Each finalist in grades 1-12 submitted an original writing artifact that was judged using a blind scoring method. We are proud of our winners representing grades five through eight from St. Francis de Sales Catholic School. Each winner received a beautiful plaque and their entries are archived in an online anthology. An in-person awards ceremony honored the talented student authors and their achievement.

## It's the Universal Church

We have been invited by the Holy Father, Pope Francis, to participate in Pre-Synod preparation for **Synod 2023**. He has called this Synod gathering of Bishops throughout the world to be a time for the Church to focus on the topic of synodality itself. The two fundamental questions that will guide this process are: "How does this 'journeying together' take place today on different levels (from the local level to the universal level), allowing the Church to proclaim the Gospel?" and "What steps is the Spirit inviting us to take in order to grow as a synodal Church?" (Preparatory Document, 2).

Here is a message from our Bishop, William Koenig last year, "I am eager to share with you that on Sunday, October 17, 2021 we will be joining dioceses throughout the world in commencing our own Diocesan Pre-Synod here in the Diocese of Wilmington." Pope Francis has challenged our Church to "journey together" and our Pre-Synod will provide us the opportunity to live out this calling.

Our parish sent five representatives to participate in the Deanery Listening Session and now we will have Listening Sessions in our parish community. *Our general gathering will be Monday, May 16<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 p.m. in the St. Francis de Sales Church Hall.*

As May, the month of Mary, begins on *next* Sunday, it seems appropriate to think of Our Lady, our Blessed Mother who, to members of our Order, is *Mary, Queen of the Knights*. In a past issue of *Columbia*, our monthly magazine, a Dominican priest, director of the Knights of Columbus Information Service, wrote: "For Knights and their families, Mary is the great model of faith. 




## ¿Qué dijo?

We have installed a Hearing Assist program to be used from your smartphone with headphones or earbuds for those who have experienced this issue.






