THE CELEBRATION OF THE SACRAMENTS

Anointing of the Sick

Those who are seriously ill or in danger of death should arrange to receive this Sacrament as soon as possible. For those able, you may come to the church at any time to request to be anointed. For those unable, please contact the parish office and one of our priests will come to you at home or in the hospital. We encourage those who are preparing for a planned hospital stay to celebrate the Sacrament before entering the hospital. *Please note, that new safety protocols may limit the priests' ability to anoint in hospitals and homes. Call to find out options.*

Baptism

Infant Baptisms are usually celebrated the Third Saturday of the month at 1:00 PM and on the Fourth Saturday of the month at 1:00 PM in Spanish. Parents & godparents are asked to attend a Baptismal Preparation class prior to the Baptism. Please contact the parish office as soon as you find out that you are expecting. Any child over 7 years old who has not been baptized should also be enrolled in parish Faith Formation and will need to attend classes for a time before being baptized.

Marriage

Please contact the parish office as soon as you become engaged and not less than *six months* in advance of your anticipated wedding date. Contact the parish *prior* to making your reception plans to ensure date availability. All couples are required to attend a Diocesan Pre-Cana Marriage Preparation Program.

Reconciliation (Penance, Confession)

Confession is on Saturdays between 12:00-1:00 PM and can also be heard by appointment.

Eucharist & Confirmation

Inquiries for Eucharist (Communion) and/or Confirmation for all school-age children should be made to the Director of Evangelization, Guenevere Neuhedel.

Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (RCIA)

For adults seeking Baptism, Communion, and/or Confirmation or even simply inquiring about the Catholic faith. Call the Parish Office at (516)568-1027

Holy Orders and the Consecrated Religious Life

The celebration of the Sacrament of Holy Orders is reserved to the bishop. Any young man who believes he is being called to serve God as a priest should speak to one of the parish priests or contact Fr. Sean Magaldi the diocesan vocations director, at 631-424-9888. Any married man who believes he is being called to serve God should consider becoming a deacon. From the Pastor's Desk



Greetings and Happy New Year! I hope everyone had a wonderful Thanksgiving! Today, the First Sunday of Advent, the Church starts her New Year! Advent comprises of the four Sundays and weekdays leading up to the Christmas celebration. It is a time where we prepare ourselves for the birth of our Lord Jesus. It is one of the busiest seasons of the liturgical year as we draw closer to the celebration of Christmas. The common prayer during this period is “Come Lord Jesus, Come!” This season we recognize that the current fallen state of humanity cannot be saved by our own effort but through God. During this time we need to remind ourselves that we need a Savior. Simply put, Advent is a season to prepare our minds and hearts for the coming of Christ.

The symbol of this season is the Advent wreath. Advent wreath is created with evergreen branches into which four candles are inserted which represents the four weeks in Advent. Three candles are purple which symbolizes prayer, penance, and sacrifice which the season is known for. A rose candle is lit on the Third Sunday of Advent called Gaudete Sunday. This candle symbolizes joy. It is called rejoicing Sunday because the faithful have arrived at the middle of Advent as we prepare and wait for the birth of our Lord Jesus.

Our celebrations this year have not been the same due to this pandemic. There are no doubts that some families had empty chairs at their table during their Thanksgiving celebrations. Either dear loved ones have gone or they may not have been able to join them and celebrate. The same things will be applicable to Christmas. In all these, Advent calls us to be watchful, hopeful, and trust in God. Help is on the way! Let us continue to be resilient.

I am so proud of all our parishioners for following the Covid-19 guidelines. We hope we do not have to close the Church again in the future. Our Church is a safe place for worship and our protocols have been working since we reopened in June. As there has been rumors of the second wave of this pandemic, please let us continue to take precautions and keep each other safe. We are doing everything to make sure everyone that comes inside this Church feels welcomed and safe to worship God. The priests are the only ones setting up for masses and counting the sacred host for now. We hope to bring our sacristans back by next year. It is required that you wear your mask and sanitize your hands before coming inside the church. Hand sanitizers are provided at the entrance of the Church. Please continue to sit six feet away at the marked pews if you are not sitting with a family member. We are working to get an air purification system in the church this winter. Please do not bring any items into the church for people to take. It is STRICTLY prohibited during these unprecedented times. If you want to donate food or clothing, please leave the food at the food bin or at the parish social office and take the clothes to the thrift store or to our Parish Social Ministry.

Many people would like to request an intention for a Mass on Christmas Day or during Christmas season. Since there are a limited number of Masses for Christmas, there will be a special Novena for Masses at Christmas - the Christmas Mass of Remembrance. Those whom would like their loved ones remembered will be able to at all the Masses during the Christmas season. There are special envelopes on the vestibule entrances of the church and in the pews. Please fill out the intention or person you wish to have remembered on the front of the envelope, include your donation, and mail it/drop it in the Sunday Mass collection or return it to the rectory office. Please do so by Thursday, Dec. 24th, Christmas Eve.




