

# PARISH MEMBERSHIP & SACRAMENTS

**Welcome** to Blessed Sacrament Parish! We hope that all residents of the Valley Stream area can feel at home in our parish and strive to be an active part of our faith community. Please take a moment to stop in the Pastoral Center Office to fill out a membership form and to meet a member of the Pastoral Staff.

## THE CELEBRATION OF THE SACRAMENTS

### **Anointing of the Sick**

Those who are seriously ill or in danger of death should arrange to receive this Sacrament as soon as possible. For those able, you may come to the church at any time to request to be anointed. For those unable, please contact the parish office and one of our priests will come to you at home or in the hospital. We encourage those who are preparing for a planned hospital stay to celebrate the Sacrament before entering the hospital. *Please note, that new safety protocols may limit the priests' ability to anoint in hospitals and homes. Call to find out options.*

### **Baptism**

Infant Baptisms are usually celebrated the Third Saturday of the month at 1:00 PM and on the Fourth Saturday of the month at 1:00 PM in Spanish. Parents & godparents are asked to attend a Baptismal Preparation class prior to the Baptism. Please contact the parish office as soon as you find out that you are expecting. Any child over 7 years old who has not been baptized should also be enrolled in parish Faith Formation and will need to attend classes for a time before being baptized.

### **Marriage**

Please contact the parish office as soon as you become engaged and not less than *six months* in advance of your anticipated wedding date. Contact the parish *prior* to making your reception plans to ensure date availability. All couples are required to attend a Diocesan Pre-Cana Marriage Preparation Program.

### **Reconciliation (Penance, Confession)**

Confession is on Saturdays between 12:00-1:00 PM and can also be heard by appointment.

### **Eucharist & Confirmation**

Inquiries for Eucharist (Communion) and/or Confirmation for all school-age children should be made to the Director of Evangelization, Guenevere Neuhedel.

### **Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (RCIA)**

For adults seeking Baptism, Communion, and/or Confirmation or even simply inquiring about the Catholic faith. Call the Parish Office at (516)568-1027

### **Holy Orders and the Consecrated Religious Life**

The celebration of the Sacrament of Holy Orders is reserved to the bishop. Any young man who believes he is being called to serve God as a priest should speak to one of the parish priests or contact Fr. Sean Magaldi the diocesan vocations director, at 631-424-9888. Any married man who believes he is being called to serve God should consider becoming a deacon. For those who are considering serving God as a consecrated sister or brother, please also contact the parish office or contact Fr. Magaldi.

## From the Pastor's Desk



Greetings and welcome to the Sixth Sunday of Easter! Today in a special way in our country we celebrate all mothers. Mother's Day is a time for us to appreciate all the women in our lives, not just our biological mothers, but all the women in our lives that have been there for us in one way or the other. Those women that support us and cheer us up. There is a popular song in Africa by Prince Nico Mbarga "Sweet mother, I no go forget you, for dey suffer wey you suffer for me". This song describes what mothers are to us. If you have not been in a good relationship with your mom, it is a time to renew the relationship and let the past go. If you are finding it difficult to forgive and renew the relationship with her, let it be just because of the love and life she has given you, for carrying you nine months in her womb and for the sleepless night you gave her in your tender age. There are so many reasons to love mothers and there are so many reasons to stay connected with them whether they reside in their home, a nursing home, or hospital. Call them often and check on them because they love you and yearn for their children. My brothers and sisters, let us cherish our parents especially mothers as we celebrate Mother's Day today. Let us not forget these women in our lives, both living and deceased, that have loved us, support us, and encouraged us to be the person God created us to be.

The readings today tell us about love. It gives us the definition of God. "God is love" (1 John 7:8). If you want to know who God is and if you want to know what love means you just have to know God, the one that loves us unconditionally. Once you love, then you know who God is. Whoever is without love, whoever hates, whoever doesn't forgive truly does not know God. God loves us unconditionally and that unconditional love was totally revealed in sending His only son who died on the cross for expiation of our sins. This is the commandment He gave us in the gospel today- to go and show love to one another. "This is my commandment ~ love one another as I love you" (John 15:12). It is a call for us to go and be God to one another by loving as God loves us. Showing unconditional love to each person we encounter. I cannot look further to see anyone that shows this unconditional love more than mothers. Mothers are the embodiments of unconditional love to their children.

This month of May is the month we honor our Blessed Mother Virgin Mary- this is called our May devotion. That is the reason we see many parishes celebrate with a May Crowning and the faithful gathering together to pray the rosary. During this month of May, I encourage all our families to pray the rosary together and dedicate their family to Mary, the mother of God and mediatrix of all graces.

June 6th is the feast of Corpus Christi, the feast of our Parish. We will celebrate this feast in a special way with a procession of the Blessed Sacrament around the block. I am inviting everyone and all families to join us in the celebration. Details of this will follow later.



SPANISH:

"La Oficina de Protección de Niños y Jóvenes está pidiendo a todos los voluntarios que se registren y asistan un taller de Virtus este año 2021 para refrescar la información contra el abuso sexual infantil y para aprender a completar su Verificación de Antecedentes y firmar los Códigos de Conducta en sus cuentas de Virtus. Estos tres requisitos diocesanos son mandatorios para los voluntarios en las parroquias y ahora se completan por internet y los talleres de Virtus se ofrecen por Zoom.

Una vez el voluntario asiste al taller de Virtus y actualiza su chequeo de antecedentes y códigos de conducta, todo el proceso lo debe repetir nuevamente en 5 años.

Cada parroquia cuenta con un Coordinador de Ambientes Seguros que ayuda a los voluntarios a actualizar sus cuentas de Virtus y registrarlos para el taller de Virtus. Para esto es necesario que los voluntarios de cada ministerio le provean su información de contacto a la señora Carmen Vázquez o a Gustavo Vásquez que son los Coordinadores Parroquiales de Ambientes Seguros para la comunidad hispana en la parroquia Blessed Sacrament. Ellos enviarán esa información a la Oficina de Protección de Niños y Jóvenes a la Coordinadora Diocesana de Ambientes Seguros, atención la Sra. Arely Mendoza-Cantos."

ENGLISH:

"The Office of Child and Youth Protection is asking all volunteers to register and attend a Virtus workshop this year 2021 to refresh information against child sexual abuse and to learn how to complete their Background Check and sign the Codes of Conduct in their Virtus accounts.

These three diocesan requirements are mandatory for volunteers in parishes and are now completed online and Virtus workshops are offered by Zoom.

Once the volunteer attends Virtus' workshop and updates his background check and codes of conduct, the whole process must be repeated again in 5 years.

Each parish has a Safe Environment Coordinator who helps volunteers update their Virtus accounts and register them for Virtus' workshop. For this it is necessary for the volunteers of each ministry to provide their contact information to Mrs. Carmen Vázquez or Gustavo Vásquez who are the Parish Coordinators of Safe Environments for the Hispanic community in the Blessed Sacrament parish. They will send that information to the Office for the Protection of Children and Youth to the Diocesan Coordinator of Safe Environments, attention Ms. Arely Mendoza-Cantos."

Long Island Head Start has an inventory of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) and has implemented COVID-19 screening procedures and policies to ensure the safety of children, families, and staff.*

*Long Island Head Start is offering virtual & on-demand learning as well as in-person classes. In addition to on-demand sessions, teachers are providing daily 15-minute live instruction sessions. The program uses the ClassTag to directly connect teachers and families for all their communications needs. Select centers are providing families with grab and go meals. Families are provided support with referrals to community resources based on their individual need.*

*For ages three to five our Head Start program provides developmental screenings and ongoing assessments, School Readiness – transition into Kindergarten, NYS Licensed Day Care Centers, Nutritious Meals (Breakfast, Lunch, Snack), outdoor playgrounds, full-day UPK at select centers, before & after care available at select centers. The Early Head Start program provides services for expectant mothers, infants, and toddlers. This program for ages birth to 3 provides diapers and formula while in session, nutritious meals (Breakfast, Lunch, Snack), outdoor playgrounds, individualized Home-Based Services, before & after care available at select centers.*
