Registration


New members are always welcome. Newcomers are encouraged to fill out a census card located at the Information Desk in the vestibule or call the parish office.

Saint Vincent de Paul Blessed Sacrament has handicapped accessible entrances to the church, social hall, and education center, and reserved pews, as well as fully accessible restrooms. Also, our sound system includes both FM receivers which can be picked up in the sacristy and an induction loop for hearing aid wearers with a T-coil.





New Mass Protocols

Effective immediately, the following protocols have been issued by Bishop Lucia:

- * Pre-registration is no longer required to attend any of our daily or weekend liturgies.
- * Individuals who are fully vaccinated are **not** required to wear masks or socially distance at Mass.
- * Individuals not fully vaccinated are asked to continue wearing masks and socially distance.
- * For those who are not fully vaccinated or for those who are fully vaccinated but wish to continue to observe safe distancing measures, seating in Section Four in the church will be reserved for those individuals.
- * Beginning this Sunday, dispensation from attending weekly Mass will be rescinded. All Catholic faithful are invited to resume full and active participation in the Eucharistic liturgy through physical attendance at either the Saturday Vigil Mass or Sunday Mass.
- * Please note that anyone who is frail or at risk due to advanced age or medical conditions is always excused from this obligation.




