Baptism

Parents are encouraged to contact us during pregnancy to ensure the prompt Baptism of their child as soon as possible after birth. Parents must be registered and attending Mass 6 months before the desired Baptism. Parents are expected to attend a Baptism Preparation class and submit all required paperwork at least one month before the Baptism date. Baptism are usually celebrated on the 4th Sunday of the month at 11:00AM. Please call 856-825-0021 to make arrangement before setting a date, prior to any other planning (i.e. hall rental, invitations, etc..)

Holy Matrimony

Couples who one or both of the engaged are registered in the parish or have a historical connection to the parish and are planning to marry at The Parish of All Saints must contact the priest to arrange a date and time first. They are also required to attend marriage preparation classes as mandated by the diocese. The period of preparation for marriage is minimum of one year as required by NJ Conference of Catholic Bishops.

Last Rites & Anointing of the Sick

The priests may be called AT ANY TIME day or night for the Last Rights. Furthermore, the priests will be happy to visit the sick to anoint them upon request.

Funerals

The preferred form of burial for a baptized Catholic is the Mass of Christian Burial in church, not a service at the funeral home. Viewings, both evening or morning, are to be arranged through the funeral home. Please remind family members of the importance of this and put it in your wills.
