Merry Christmas, Brothers and Sisters

As I said in a homily a few weeks ago, Christmas time is definitely the best time in the world for kids. Between the presents, the music, lights and decorations and just the sheer excitement of



the season, there can be no better time during the vear.

But when we get older and we experience more of the bumps and bruises life gives us, sometimes the holidays can be a mixed bag. The suicide rates are at their highest at this time annually, and many people experience a "funk" or depression.

Maybe this is because so many of the people we love and associate with the joy of the holidays leave us over time, for one reason or another. This time of year dredges up old memories and they can be bittersweet. The holidays seem to magnify and intensify our emotions.

But none of this has anything to do with the reality of Christmas, which is this: Christ had a plan to save us. He had to die for us to cancel our sins. He began this mission in Bethlehem as a baby, being born under the most depressing conditions possible. Mary gave birth in a cave, with no heat or hot water, no one to help, and just animals to witness the greatest event in history.
