Fr. Chris was born Nov 2, 1966 as the youngest son of Janina & Czeslaw Stanibula. After finishing Kosciuszko Primary School, he attended Technical High, where he obtained diplomas in technical engineering and passed the examinations to the Catholic University in Lublin, Poland. Having completed a Bachelor of Philosophy degree in 1990, he passed an English as a 2nd language. In 1991 he was invited to an American Seminary in MI. When he finished studies (M.Div.) in 1995 present Cardinal O'Malley ordained him in Fall River diocese. Fr. Stanibula studied at the Catholic University between 1986-90 and from 2008 to 2012 concluded with doctoral dissertation on Christian formation and human development which earned him doctorate (S.T.D./Ph.D. ) in 2016. Most of his professional works have been related to the pastoral, hospital and school ministry in New Bedford, Attleboro, Fall River and Cape Cod. Lately Bishop da Cunha has assigned him to be the Administrator at St. Anthony & St. Rita after serving the St. Pius X community and JP2 High School on Cape Cod. His recent book *The Christian Self Formation: Anthropology of Becoming* is available at [krzysstanibula.wordpress.com](http://krzysstanibula.wordpress.com) and at his office. In his free time he likes reading inspirational books and enjoys walking in the forest.
