

PRO-LIFE SIGNATURE DRIVE Members of our Prolife Committee will be available this weekend and next weekend with a signature drive for an Initiative Petition for a Law to Preserve the Lives of Children Born Alive. This proposed law would require that, notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, if a child is born alive, all reasonable steps in keeping with good medical practice shall be taken to preserve the life of a child born alive.

The Vatican has designated an ancient prayer attributed to St. Isidore of Seville (560-636 AD) to guide our synodal journey: We stand before you, Holy Spirit as we gather in Your name. With You alone to guide us, make Yourself at home in our hearts; teach us the way we must go and how we are to pursue it. We are weak and sinful; do not let us promote disorder. As you know we have elected two Eucharistic ambassadors **Don Fleming & Bob Cattel.** Congratulations! As Sts. Rita/Anthony Parish we officially begin our response to our Bishop's invitation to participate in the Synod with a

Votive Mass of the Holy Spirit to set the proper stage for an effective listening session. Celebrating a Synod means walking on the same road, walking together, with the Lord Jesus. Last weekend, Pope Francis opened the Synod proposing three verbs to describe the task at hand: Encounter, Listen, Discern. I wanted to share with you some excerpts from the Holy Father's homily focusing on these three verbs. Encounter, taking time to encounter the Lord and one another and to hearing what the Spirit wants to say to us. Time to look others in the eye. Everything changes once we are capable of genuine encounters with him and with one another. Listen. "Are we good at listening? How good is the "hearing" of our heart? Participating in a Synod means following in his footsteps, listening to his word along with the words of others. Let us not soundproof our hearts. Discern. "Encounter and listening are not ends in themselves, leaving everything just as it was before. Through dialogue, Jesus helps the rich young man discern. Jesus encourages that man to look within and discern in that light what his heart truly treasures. In these days, Jesus calls us to free ourselves from all that is worldly and to ask ourselves what it is that God wants to say to us in this time "that we may journey together to eternal life and not stray from the way of truth and what is right.
