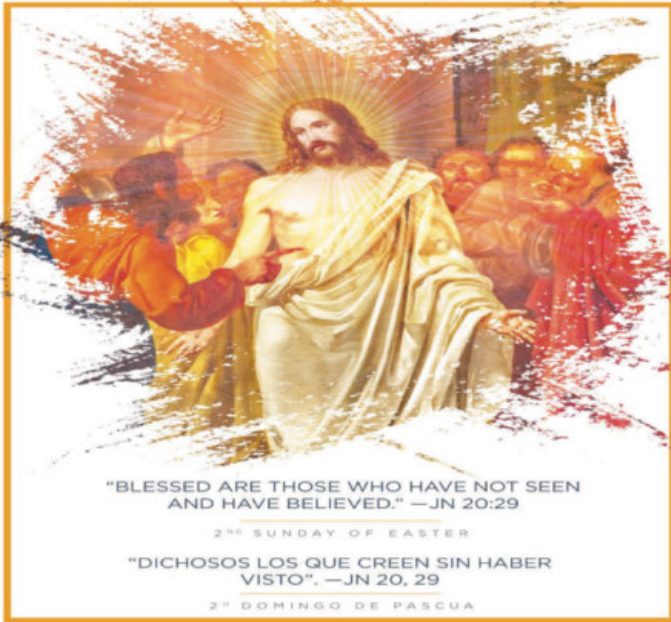

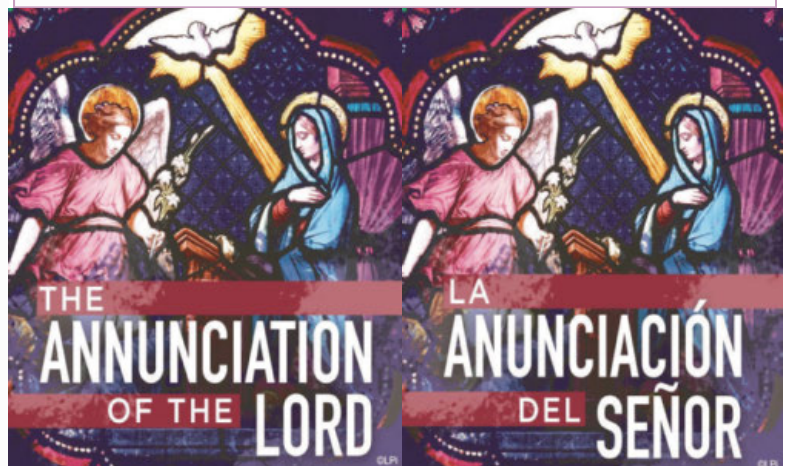

Baptisms: Scheduled & Celebrated by appointment. Parents should call the rectory at least our weeks in advance, and must attend instructions. Church Law requires that only Catholics in good standing are eligible to be Godparents. No Baptisms scheduled during Lent.

Anointing of the Sick: We offer this sacrament to those who are seriously ill, at home or in the hospital. We urge you to contact the office before someone goes to the hospital for an operation. (A priest may not be available later.)

Ministry of the Sick: Holy Communion will be brought to the sick, upon request. The bedridden or chronically ill can be placed on the "Eucharistic Ministers" visitation schedule.

WEDDING: Engaged couples must make arrangements in person, at the office at least six months in advance.

CONFESSION: Verplanck location 4:00 to 4:30 pm on Saturday or anytime by appointment.

SEGUNDO DOMINGO DE PASCUA

La figura de Tomás es solamente una actitud de "anti-resurrección"; nos quiere presentar las dificultades a que nuestra fe está expuesta; es como quien quiere probar la realidad de la resurrección como si se tratara de una vuelta a esta vida. Tomás, uno de los Doce, debe enfrentarse con el misterio de la resurrección de Jesús desde sus seguridades humanas y desde su soledad, porque no estaba con los discípulos en aquel momento en que Jesús, después de la resurrección, se les hizo presente, para mostrarse como el Viviente. Este es un dato que no es nada secundario a la hora de poder comprender el sentido de lo que se nos quiere poner de manifiesto en esta escena: la fe, vivida desde el personalismo, está expuesta a mayores dificultades. Desde ahí no hay camino alguno para ver que Dios resucita y salva.

Tomás no se fía de la palabra de sus hermanos; quiere creer desde él mismo, desde sus posibilidades, desde su misma debilidad. En definitiva, se está exponiendo a un camino arduo. Pero Dios no va a fallar ahora tampoco. Jesucristo, el resucitado, va a «mostrarse» (es una forma de hablar que encierra mucha simbología; concretamente podemos hablar de la simbología del "encuentro") como Tomás quiere, como muchos queremos que Dios se nos muestre. Pero así no se "encontrará" con el Señor. Esa no es forma de "ver" nada, ni entender nada, ni creer nada.

Tomás, pues, debe comenzar de nuevo: no podrá tocar con sus manos las heridas de las manos del Resucitado, de sus pies y de su costado, porque éste, no es una *imagen+, sino la realidad pura de quien tiene la vida verdadera. Y es ante esa experiencia de una vida distinta, pero verdadera, cuando Tomás se siente llamado a creer como sus hermanos, como todos los hombres. Diciendo «Señor mío y Dios mío», es aceptar que la fe deja de ser puro personalismo para ser comunión que se enraíce en la confianza comunitaria, y experimentar que el Dios de Jesús es un Dios de vida y no de muerte.

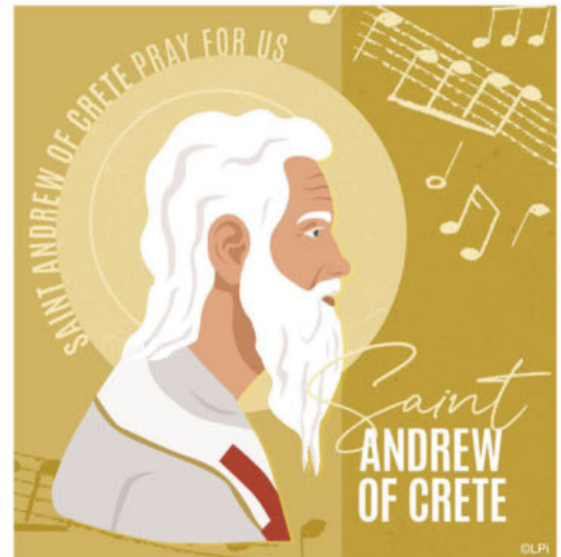

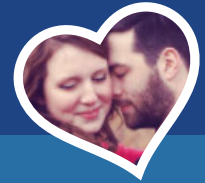
