



"If anyone wishes to be first, he shall be the Fr. Kelly last of all and the servant of all."

Taking a child, he placed it in their midst, and putting his arms around it, he said to them,

"Whoever receives one child such as this in my name, receives me; and whoever receives me, receives not me but the One who sent me." Mark 9: 30-37

But Christ calls us to embrace the uncomplicated but genuine faith of a child: to love God and others without condition or expectation. Christ calls us to the simple faith of a child: to love without condition or return, with honesty and faithfulness. Only in embracing such child-like kindness, compassion, generosity and forgiveness can we attain true greatness in the Kingdom of God.






