Palm Sunday

Dear Fellow Parishioners,

As we gather for Holy Week it is good to take some time to review the Lenten journey we are making as the Catholic Community of Sacred Heart. We were asked to take a wrist band to identify us when we are "off campus" and take the risk to talk with other members of the community regarding the Lenten faith journey. How did you do? We prayed each week, "Holy Spirit, guide us on our Lenten journey." Listening to the Holy Spirit begins with sharpening our skills in listening to each other. How did you do? Our homily series focused on being on this faith journey, not in isolation but together; "To be or not to be church." Church is not a building; it is the community that gathers as the people of God. We were encouraged to take the risk to reach out to others. How did you do?

The pandemic has "scattered the flock" in many ways and I am challenging us to regroup. We all have various levels of comfort, need, and interest levels of involvement as community. So, this Easter weekend we are going to invite you to let us know where you are at as a member of our community by taking the time to let us know where, if and how you are interested in connecting with other members of our faith community. There is a sample of the survey in today's bulletin that we will be asking you, over Easter weekend, to fill out.

Holy Week begins with the Vigil Mass of Palm Sunday. Through prayer and our rich Catholic rituals, we have an opportunity to make an ordinary week into extraordinary week. There is an opportunity for confession on Tuesday evening at our Tenebrae service. When is the last time you went? Now is the time. Jesus asked his disciples in the garden of Gethsemane "Will you spend some time with me in prayer?" Holy Thursday will offer you an opportunity to do so. We will process in prayer Good Friday for our brothers and sisters in Ukraine during Walk the Walk. We will pray for peace in Ukraine at Stations of the Cross. How will you take advantage of the deep meaning of Good Friday events? As we gather around the Easter fire in front of the church, we have a change to celebrate the light of Christ leading us from the darkness of sin to His own wonderful light. Will you join in the celebration? What will you do to make this week Holy?

2022 Lenten Care For Creation Calendar

Palm Sunday

"Hosanna! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!" As we enter this holiest of weeks in the liturgical year, let us commit to following Jesus with our whole heart, mind and body.

When considering following Jesus with our whole body - we need to ensure that our bodies are not polluted with plastics which pose a threat to human health as well as adversely affecting our world.

- -Ordering take-out? Say "no" to the utensils, straws, and napkins
- -Attempt to ban the "plastics trifecta" plastic bags, plastic straws, and polystyrene - from your local town/city, county or state
- -Stop buying water! Carry a reusable bottle some have filters!
- -Buy in bulk versus single-serve yogurts, travel size toiletries or tiny packaged snacks. Consider the product-to-packaging ratio.

Message Shaper's Corner Palm Sunday

Palm Sunday, also called Passion Sunday, marks the beginning of Holy Week. During this week, we prepare ourselves for Easter by prayerful reflection upon the events of Jesus' passion and death.

Throughout Holy Week, as we meditate on the cross, we ask again and anew what it means to make the statement of faith that Jesus, in his obedient suffering and dying, revealed himself to us as God's Son and brought to fulfillment the Kingdom of God.

Reflection Questions

- Adults: When have you felt that you betrayed the confidence of another, as Peter did when he denied Jesus?
- ♦ Kids: When have you let someone down who trusted you? How did you feel?
