LENTEN TRIVIA

The pretzel was *the* Lenten treat of ancient Christianity. In the 400's, when the Great Fast of Lent included total abstinence from all meat and dairy products, Roman Christians made a simple bread out of flour, water, and salt.

And to remind themselves that Lent was a time of prayer, they shaped the bread in the form of praying arms.

Long before Christians folded their hands in prayer, they prayed with their arms crossed in front of them, as Byzantine Christians still do today. The result was called *bracellae*, Latin for "little arms". From this word comes the German *brezel* or *prezel* and our pretzel.
