
## PARISH MEMBERSHIP

If you regularly attend Mass here at St. Denis, you are encouraged to register in the parish at the office during the week. Summer Parish Office hours are Tuesday-Wednesday 9:00 AM - 3:00 PM & Thursday 9:00 AM - 12:00 PM. Please note that a family must be registered at St. Denis in order for their children to be enrolled in our religious education program.

**INFANT BAPTISM:** Takes place normally following the 11:30 AM Mass on Sundays. Families have the option of scheduling a baptism during the 9:00 AM Mass on Sundays. First-time parents are required to attend a pre-baptismal session; please call the parish office to schedule.

**MARRIAGE:** Engaged couples must contact the parish office at least six months in advance of scheduling a wedding.

## PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Parishioners and Friends of St Denis,

A happy, safe and enjoyable Fourth of July to you all! My favorite verse of the hymn "America, the Beautiful" is the second, which ends like this: "America, America, God mend thine every flaw / Confirm thy soul in self-control, / Thy liberty in law."

(A disclaimer: what follows is a reprise of a "Pastor's Corner" I wrote two years ago.)

Is **patriotism** a *virtue* or a *vice*? That seems like a reasonable question to ask over this long Fourth of July weekend, when our nation engages in overt displays of patriotism as we celebrate our independence.

So, let's try to define patriotism. Patriotism is defined in terms of a kind of loyalty to a particular nation which only those possessing that nationality can exhibit, i.e., only a French person can be patriotic about France. Patriotism is not to be confused with a mindless loyalty to one's own particular nation which has no regard at all for the characteristics of that particular nation. Patriotism generally and characteristically involves a peculiar regard not just for one's own nation, but for the particular characteristics and merits and achievements of one's own nation.

To say this is to draw attention to the fact that patriotism is one of a class of loyalty-exhibiting virtues, other members of which are marital fidelity, the love of one's own family and kin, friendship, and loyalty to such institutions as schools and sports teams.

And if patriotism is a virtue, then, like all virtues as the great Philosopher Aristotle taught, "the virtue lies in the mean" (or "the middle"), meaning that a moral virtue is a disposition to behave in the right manner and is a mean (midpoint) between extremes of deficiency and excess, which are *vices*. So, for example, the virtue of *courage* lies at the midpoint between a deficiency of courage, which would be *cowardice*, and an excess of courage, which would be *rashness* or *foolhardiness*.

What would be an excess of patriotism? We might define that as *chauvinism* or *nationalism*. What would be a deficiency of patriotism? We might define that as *indifferentism* or, taken to the extreme, *treason*.

So, this Fourth of July weekend, let's exercise the virtue of patriotism reasonably and rationally, giving thanks to God, the Giver of all good gifts, for the great merits and achievements of this wonderful nation of ours.

**Access to Bishop Barron's Word on Fire—**  
*Our parish has a subscription to Bishop Barron's Word on Fire ENGAGE. All of Bishop Barron's Word on Fire content is available to you in short video segments through St. Denis's Flocknote page. Take a few minutes to check it out and see the wealth of resources at your fingertips!*

If you are part of our Flocknote email list you have access to Word on Fire (WoF), but may not have known that. It is easy to access once you know how. You must first create a Flocknote login.

1. Go to [flocknote.com/login](https://flocknote.com/login)
2. Enter your email address (the address that already received Flocknote emails)
3. Click "Reset or create a password" below the big blue "Sign In" button.
4. After that, click the yellow "Reset my password" button, and follow the prompts from there. Flocknote will send you a link to create a password.

Once you have your Flocknote login and password, log in to Flocknote. Once in Flocknote on the St. Denis dashboard you will see a large picture block of Bishop Barron that says, "You've got Word on Fire ENGAGE." Click on the orange button that says "Visit WoFDigital.org" and you have arrived!

### *Some notes regarding Mass attendance*

With a letter dated June 6<sup>th</sup>, Bishop Libasci of the Diocese of Manchester eased most restrictions and cautions regarding the celebration of public Masses in the parishes in New Hampshire. Social distancing is no longer required and the wearing of a face covering is optional. It is up to the individual to determine what he or she feels most comfortable with while participating at Mass.

In a second letter dated June 8, the Bishop informed the faithful of the Diocese of Manchester that the Bishops of New England would all be reinstating the Sunday obligation to attend Mass as of the weekend of June 19<sup>th</sup>/20<sup>th</sup>, 2021. Obviously, anyone who is sick is not bound by this obligation, as was the case even before the global pandemic. The Offertory Procession (the bringing up of the gifts of bread and wine), the exchange of the Sign of Peace among the people, and receiving the Precious Blood from a common chalice remain suspended.

The church is open daily for private prayer from 7:00 am - 4:00 pm. There are days when it is open later than 4:00 pm such as Wednesdays when Confessions are heard from 4:00 pm - 4:30 pm and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament is celebrated at 4:50 pm.

## OUTREACH

The title for the weekend offertory for the last 2 weekends in July is set aside for the **Parish-to-Parish Support Fund** of the Diocese of Manchester. This collection provides funds that allow parishes in New Hampshire experiencing financial difficulties to request grant assistance. This is one of four “assessed collections” in the Diocese of Manchester, in which the Diocese assesses each parish a certain amount of its annual income as a minimum contribution. Any amount collected in excess of the assessment will be sent in its entirety to the diocese.

The other three assessed special collections are the Diocesan Seminarian Fund (in January), the Peter’s Pence Collection (in June), and the Catholic University of America and United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (in September). All other appeals have no stated minimum.

**The Haven** works every day to support people experiencing poverty by providing food, shelter, education, and service coordination. We will continue to support these families and individuals, as well as anyone who may find themselves experiencing economic challenges resulting from the COVID-19 crisis.
