
PARISH MEMBERSHIP

Please note that a family must be registered at St. Denis in order for their children to be enrolled in our religious education program.

INFANT BAPTISM: Takes place normally following the 11:30 AM Mass on Sundays. Families have the option of scheduling a baptism during the 9:00 AM Mass on Sundays. First-time parents are required to attend a pre-baptismal session; please call the parish office to schedule.

MARRIAGE: Engaged couples must contact the parish office at least six months in advance of scheduling a wedding.

PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Parishioners and Friends of St Denis,

The month of August kicks off with the Feast of **St. Alphonsus Liguori**, Bishop and Doctor of the Church. He lived from 1696-1787, so his life spanned most of the 18th century. He is the founder of the Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer, better known as the Redemptorists. But he was also a spiritual writer, composer, musician, artist, poet, lawyer, scholastic philosopher, and theologian. He is the patron saint of confessors and moral theologians in the Church. The most-cherished Christmas carol for the Italian people, *Tu scendi dalle stelle* ("From starry skies descending") was composed by St. Alphonsus. His writings on morality and Christian virtue are still considered the finest of their kind and are used extensively in the training of seminarians. St. Alphonsus also wrote many books of spirituality, which are read by countless people throughout the world. St. Alphonsus wrote what are perhaps the most-widely known and loved meditations for the Stations of the Cross. His book *The Glories of Mary* is a classic of Catholic devotion to the Blessed Mother.



The original icon of Our Lady of Perpetual Help, having come from an Orthodox monastery on the island of Crete, has been in Rome since 1499, and now resides in the Redemptorist church of Sant'Alfonso di Liguori in the Via Merulana, near the Basilica of St. Mary Major. The Redemptorists were charged by Pope Pius IX in the 19th century to promote devotion to the image of Our Lady of Perpetual Help.

Long-time residents of the Upper Valley (on the Vermont side) will remember the strong presence of the Redemptorists in our area until the late 1980s. They built **Our Lady of Perpetual Help** in Bradford, VT, **St. Eugene's** in Wells River, VT, **Our Lady of Light** in So. Strafford, VT, and **St. Francis** in Norwich, VT to serve the needs of the Catholic population in the eastern part of the state.

Access to Bishop Barron's Word on Fire—Our parish has a subscription to Bishop Barron's Word on Fire ENGAGE. All of Bishop Barron's Word on Fire content is available to you in short video segments through St. Denis's Flocknote page. Take a few minutes to check it out and see the wealth of resources at your fingertips!



If you are part of our Flocknote email list you have access to Word on Fire (WoF), but may not have known that. It is easy to access once you know how. You must first create a Flocknote login.

1. Go to flocknote.com/login
2. Enter your email address (the address that already received Flocknote emails)
3. Click "Reset or create a password" below the big blue "Sign In" button.
4. After that, click the yellow "Rest my password" button, and follow the prompts from there. Flocknote will send you a link to create a password.

Once you have your Flocknote login and password, log in to Flocknote. Once in Flocknote on the St. Denis dashboard you will see a large picture block of Bishop Barron that says, "You've got Word on Fire ENGAGE." Click on the orange button that says "Visit WoFDigital.org" and you have arrived!

Some notes regarding Mass attendance

With a letter dated June 6th, Bishop Libasci of the Diocese of Manchester eased most restrictions and cautions regarding the celebration of public Masses in the parishes in New Hampshire. Social distancing is no longer required and the wearing of a face covering is optional. It is up to the individual to determine what he or she feels most comfortable with while participating at Mass.

In a second letter dated June 8, the Bishop informed the faithful of the Diocese of Manchester that the Bishops of New England would all be reinstating the Sunday obligation to attend Mass as of the weekend of June 19th/20th, 2021. Obviously, anyone who is sick is not bound by this obligation, as was the case even before the global pandemic. The Offertory Procession (the bringing up of the gifts of bread and wine), the exchange of the Sign of Peace among the people, and receiving the Precious Blood from a common chalice remain suspended.

The church is open daily for private prayer from 7:00 am - 4:00 pm. There are days when it is open later than 4:00 pm such as Wednesdays when Confessions are heard from 4:00 pm - 4:30 pm and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament is celebrated at 4:50 pm.

Mission Cooperative Appeal 2021: This year's appeal will take place at our Masses on the weekend of **August 28th/29th**. This year, the Diocese of Manchester assigned to us the **Dominican Province of St Joseph the Worker in Nigeria and Ghana** in West Africa. The Dominican presence in English-speaking West Africa was established by the Province of St Albert the Great (Chicago) in this country. Over the decades, it has grown to be one of the largest Dominican Provinces in the world. **Fr. Raymond Nwabueze, O.P.** will preach at all three weekend Masses, asking for your assistance in supporting the ministries of his home Province. Thank you, in advance, for your generosity.

The title for the weekend offertory for last two weekends in August are going to support the **NH Missionaries Abroad and Migrant & Refugees Ministry in NH**. This collection supports The Good Samaritan Home in Colombia, run by Claire Aucoin. In addition, a portion of this collection supports the diocesan ministries to migrants and refugees throughout the state of NH. The Good Samaritan Home was initiated at the Parish of Our Lady of Perpetual Help in Cartago, Colombia in October 1963. Since that time, diocesan priests, Sisters of Mercy, and lay volunteers from our diocese have served there. Ms. Aucoin, RN of Henniker, NH went to Cartago in 1966 to join the medical/health program and has been there since. Claire opened many new services and now cares for over 400 people, the sick, elderly, incapacitated persons and a home for sickly/ abandoned children over the years



The Listen Community Dinner Program resumed on July 6th. We are looking for volunteers to help provide and serve meals to the needy. We are part of a larger program run by the Listen Community Center, and our job is to prepare and serve food to approximately 90
