The feast of manifestation, Epiphany, is celebrated on January 6, commemorating the arrival of the Three Kings (the Magi) in Bethlehem, bearing gifts to worship the Christ Child. The blessing of homes on Epiphany is when each house is painted with the inscription "xx+C+M+B+xx" for the Latin phrase *Christus Mansionem Benedicat* (Christ bless this house).

This year will be "20+C+M+B+22"

These letters are coincidentally, the first initials of the names of the Magi; Caspar, Melchior and Balthasar. At the Masses this weekend, a card with chalk will be distributed with instructions on how to perform this blessing at your home. May the gifts of the Magi bring you peace and contentment throughout the New Year!

Please be aware that, this year, the day of prayer and penance for offenses committed against life is **Saturday, January 22** – a day Catholics should observe by offering sacrifices and prayers to God for the conversion of hearts towards pro-life.




