Covid Protocols

Protect Yourself and Others:

- A reminder that if you are feeling ill in any way, or have been in contact with someone who is, you should not be coming to Mass and putting others at risk.
- Enter/exit through the main front doors only.
- Seating will be in every other pew. Those not related to each other should maintain distance between themselves and others, which will involve spacing as you share pews. Greeters will be at the door to assist with seating and to answer any questions.
- **Masks are to be worn, covering both nose and mouth, according to Portsmouth City ordinance, Diocesan guidelines, and safe practices recommended by the CDC, lowered only when you stand before the priest/minister to receive communion, and then replaced.**
- A basket for your offertory envelope will be at the main entrance to receive your offerings as you enter or leave.
- **Form a single, spaced line down the center of the aisle for Communion, turning to the right or left once you reach the front.**
- When Mass ends, maintain social distance as you proceed out the doors. Do not congregate on the front plaza, and keep masks in place until you reach your vehicle.

Parish Mass Online and on TV

Every week our parish's 4:00 PM Saturday Mass is recorded for the benefit of all who are sick, at risk, or vulnerable and therefore unable to rejoin us for Mass in the church at this time. The Mass then airs on Channel 98 (local public access television) on Sunday morning at 10:00 AM and is repeated at 7:00 PM on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Dear Family in the Lord,

On this glorious day, the last Sunday of the Liturgical Year, the Solemnity of Christ, King of the Universe, we have the joy of re-entering our beautifully restored Church and resuming the celebration of the Divine Mysteries within these walls! I can best express my overflowing heart at this moment with the words of Psalm 84: "O how lovely is your dwelling place, Lord God of Hosts, my heart and my flesh are longing for your courts!" Situated on this holy hill, which has housed the Catholic community of Portsmouth since 1850, we can enjoy our beautifully repurposed use of the holy ground that this has been, and continues to be, within our local seacoast community.


I ask the Lord, with His abundant graces, to bless all who helped with this vision, its plan, and its design, and all those whose labors and talent brought this into reality, as well as all who have generously supported this endeavor to restore and repurpose what has been given to us as a legacy of faith and which we now renew for future generations! Everything our eyes will take in expresses a great deal more—it expresses time, talent, and treasure invested for His honor and glory! It will stand, for years to come, as a declaration to those who come after us, of the faith that grounded us in these trying times, and the One to whom we renew our commitment as disciples!

Architects, construction workers, electricians, engineers, visionaries, artists, and a variety of tradesmen all were brought together in this common purpose. Many of them were personally touched and renewed in faith by sharing in this "work of the Lord." All that has gone into the past five years—whether seen or unseen—has brought us to this point in our life as a Catholic Community who has sought to move from "Maintenance to Mission." We are blessed with a beautifully restored church, and renewed buildings that now serve as Parish Center, Parish Offices, and Vianney House residence. Our repurposed grounds help us meet current needs and provide a beautiful setting within our neighborhood. The recently constructed, and filled-to-capacity, St. Patrick Academy continues to expand on the over 150 years of Catholic education in this community, and soon, the gym under construction there will be complete and aid in developing our children's growth in mind, body, and soul! We are richly blessed!

The very first use of our restored Church is a Baptism, which will be celebrated by Deacon Joe, himself baptized here, using our new Font. This Sunday, as we rejoice over the return of the Eucharistic Lord to the tabernacle in our church, we offer you the opportunity to come to rejoice in His presence within His holy dwelling place with some time of adoration. The Blessed Sacrament will be exposed from 12N to 4PM today.

So, welcome back home! We now resume, as this bulletin outlines, our regular daily schedule, with opportunities for Mass, Confession, and Adoration throughout the week. The doors are open from 7AM to 7PM daily. Now, as we move into a new Liturgical year, we move more boldly toward Mission—restoring our appreciation for our Catholic faith, bringing out and making it more obvious, rather than "beiged over," as the decorative painting reminds us. As we worship, surrounded by the images of enhanced angels, looking up at how they hover between heaven and earth as we celebrate the sacred mysteries, we then allow our gaze to move toward the sanctuary to see the ceiling (the heavens) descend, so to speak, and we are reminded that at each Mass heaven meets earth! And, in so realizing in ways more fully than ever, can we echo the words inscribed above the altar—SANCTUS, SANCTUS, SANCTUS—Holy is the Lord! And, in the loft—GLORIA—to Him be the Glory!

NEW! Parking Information

Next weekend we step into a new Church Year as we begin the Season of Advent. It's a season that can do so much for us if we carve out some space and embrace Advent living. But, for so many, the secularism around us can have it be all about pre-Christmas rush and all the "stuff." Here are some simple opportunities your parish family holds out to you to make it different this year!

Advent Daily Reflection Booklets

Any remaining booklets are at the church entrances for your use to help you pause and reflect in these days, allowing the richness of the scriptures to create an intensified dwelling of Christ within you and your home. Take one!

Advent Wreath At Home

Confessions will be heard daily, with opportunities Monday through Saturday at 8:30 AM; Saturday afternoon at 3:00 PM; Sunday afternoon at 3:45 PM and again from 5:30 to 6:00 PM, and 6:30 to 7:00 PM (before and after Evensong, while Adoration is ongoing). Don't delay! Don't miss this *most important* of all Christmas preparations!


Advent Evensong and Benediction

will take place on Sundays at 6:00 PM, **November 29, December 6, 13, and 20**. It's a brief half hour in a candlelight setting, with reflection, intercession, and the beautiful anthems of the season. It's a restful, focused, opportunity to simply come before Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament and receive His blessing for our living of these days. *(Please note that Adoration opportunity precedes at 5:30 PM and follows until 7:00 PM for those who want to linger, as well as Confession availability.)*

Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament

is possible daily in our church throughout Advent. Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament takes place Monday through Saturday from 7:00 to 7:55 AM; Thursdays in addition from 8:30 AM to 5:00 PM; Sundays from 5:30 to 6:00 PM Evensong, then after Evensong until 7:00 PM. Sitting quietly before Him, experiencing Him as Emmanuel – God with us! Discover this awesome gift!

Candlelight Evening Mass will be offered on **Wednesday evenings at 6:30 PM on December 2, 9, and 16**. This unique style of celebration, in the darkness, offered “ad orientem” at the high altar, and accompanied by the Gregorian chant of the ancient “Rorate Mass,” is soul-stirring and a great mid-week way to keep focus!
