

## *Covid Protocols*

- A reminder that if you are feeling ill in any way, or have been in contact with someone who is, you should not be coming to Mass and putting others at risk.
- Enter/exit through the main front doors only.
- Seating will be in every other pew. Those not related to each other should maintain distance between themselves and others, which will involve spacing as you share pews. Greeters will be at the door to assist with seating and to answer any questions.
- **Masks are to be worn, covering both nose and mouth, according to State of NH Mandate, Portsmouth City ordinance, Diocesan guidelines, and safe practices recommended by the CDC, lowered only when you stand before the priest/minister to receive communion, and then replaced.**
- A basket for your offertory envelope will be at the main entrance to receive your offerings as you enter or leave.
- **Form a spaced line down the center aisle for Communion, returning to your pew by the side aisles.**
- When Mass ends, maintain social distance as you proceed out the doors. Do not congregate on the front plaza, and keep masks in place until you reach your vehicle.

# The Pastor's Letter

Dear Family in the Lord,

The joy of Advent shines forth with an inspiring message of hope on this third Sunday – “Gaudete Sunday” – with rose vestments and Advent wreath candle, reminding us of the rose streaks across the winter sky as dawn draws near, and focusing us on the Light and Life we will celebrate at this season’s conclusion, and ultimately be invited to share fully when He comes again in glory. Gaudete! Rejoice in Hope!

What is more, is that this day’s liturgy reminds us that joy is basic to being authentically Christian, and that our vocation is to radiate that joy. Experience bears it out that rejoicing is not always the hallmark of a Christian. All too frequently, Christianity is associated with sadness and dour faces. Some give way to thinking that the beaten dog look is what “holiness” is supposed to look like! We must certainly see the reality of our Lord, His cross and our share in it, and not subscribe to a cross-less Christianity. However, we must not lose sight of what is beyond His cross (and ours).

The final words of our Lord as he was drawing near to departing this world at His ascension must ring in our hearts and find expression in our lives: “These things I have spoken to you that my joy might be in you and your joy might be complete.” (John 15:11) We were created for happiness. It is the purpose of our whole being, and we spend our lives searching and trying to attain it. Somehow this happiness seems to escape us as we search for it in the wrong places, or settle for passing pleasure as a substitute for lasting joy. True joy is much more than just a smile on a face or a “feel good.” We can sustain our joy and even be “joyful in hope,” as the Liturgy expresses it, when we have an


awareness that God is “Emmanuel” – *God with us* – and we can thus maintain a peace of soul, even when we might be surrounded by conflict or difficulties. There is an old saying that a boat begins to sink not when it’s surrounded by water, but rather, when the water fills it. The scriptures express this reality of maintaining joy and hope by being “in the world but not of the world.”

On that Christmas night when God came among us in the person of Jesus, the Incarnate Word, He filled the world “with glad tidings of great joy,” as the angels announced to shepherds. Shepherds had to leave their routine, the familiar, and go to encounter the reason and source of this joy. They in turn went to announce to others to come and discover what was occurring right under their noses. That joy was the convincing factor, I’m sure, that led townspeople to go and see.

The “tidings of great joy” were to be shared by all people, the angels said. And so we, as followers of Christ, as those who cradle Him within the manger of our hearts in every communion, are sent to proclaim by our daily choices, values, and demeanor, the tidings of great joy – the reason for our hope! We are bearers of the Light that must permeate the darkness – which is rather deep these days! Let’s receive the grace He gives, clear out what robs us of joy, experience mercy that gives us reason to be joyful, and then go forth and be creative in finding ways, ordinary ways, of proclaiming “tidings of great joy” – for, through it all, He is “Emmanuel” – God with us, and with each worthy communion, even more intimately, He is God within us!

## Christmas Mass Attendance BY RESERVATION ONLY

Due to ongoing concerns, and the need to follow the protocols set out by both the State and our Diocese in these days of pandemic, we will join with other parishes in our area requiring pre-registration for Christmas Masses. This will allow those who wish to come to be assured of a place while limits are still followed. Please note the following:

- ◆ You need to call our office to give your name, number in your party, and the Mass time you wish to register for. Calls will be taken, first come, first served, **only** between 9AM and 12 Noon, and 1 to 5PM Monday—Friday.
- ◆ If you find you have a change of plans and cannot attend, please call the office so that we may accommodate others who wish to come.
- ◆ **You cannot make a reservation by email or by leaving a message. You need to speak to Kathy or Mary Kay directly in our office, 436-4555.**

But, for so many, the secularism around us can have it be all about pre-Christmas rush and all the “stuff.” Here are some simple opportunities your parish family holds out to you to make it different this year!*

### Advent Evensong and Benediction

will take place **TONIGHT** at 6:00 PM and **NEXT** Sunday, **December 20**. It's a brief half hour in a candlelight setting, with reflection, intercession, and the beautiful anthems of the season. It's a restful, focused, opportunity to simply come before Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament and receive His blessing for our living of these days. *(Please note that Adoration opportunity precedes at 5:30 PM and follows until 7:00 PM for those who want to linger, as well as Confession availability.)*

### Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament

is possible daily in our church throughout Advent. Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament takes place Monday through Saturday from 7:00 to 7:55 AM; Wednesdays from 8:30 AM to 6:00 PM also; Sundays from 5:30 to 6:00 PM Evensong, then after Evensong until 7:00 PM. Sitting quietly before Him, experiencing Him as Emmanuel – God with us! Discover this awesome gift!

**Candlelight Evening Mass** will be offered **THIS Wednesday evening at 6:30 PM**. This unique style of celebration, in the darkness, offered “ad orientem” at the high altar, and accompanied by the Gregorian chant of the ancient “Rorate Mass,” is soul-stirring and a great mid-week way to keep focus!

**Weekday Morning Mass** is offered at 8:00 AM Monday through Saturday. What a great start and focus to your day to keep you grounded in the reason for the season!

**Confessions** will be heard daily, with opportunities Monday through Saturday at 8:30 AM; Saturday afternoon at 3:00 PM; Sunday afternoon at 3:45 PM and again from 5:30 to 6:00 PM, and 6:30 to 7:00 PM (before and after Evensong, while Adoration is ongoing). Don't delay! Don't miss this *most important* of all Christmas preparations!

Flyers with the explanation of this beautiful custom, along with accompanying prayers, will be available with them. If you've yet to, we encourage you to explore the possibility of introducing this beautiful “domestic church” tradition in your home this Christmas! For those of Slavic background, the name of these wafers will be well known—Oplatek! This translates as “an oblation”—an offering!

**Restoration/Repair Update**

Over the past weeks, some finishing touches were added on the grounds. Drainage areas were finished, new stairs installed behind the church, parking lots were striped, and a few other minor things. We will resume grounds work in the Spring with the majority of plantings, which will include trees, shrubs, and perennials, along with finishing touches for gardens.

Two special outdoor tribute areas will be installed. One will have a cross from the old school in a monument with a bronze plaque commemorating the school on site here and the presence of the Sisters of Mercy. A second will be a monument to honor all veterans with a new flag and pole to clearly indicate to all who pass by, not simply those who come in to our church, our prayers for our nation and our gratitude to our veterans for their selfless service. Finally, new crosses will be placed on church front and tower. Watch for more!

Inside, the interior vestibule doors, replicas of the originals but with restored stained glass and antique hardware, were installed. The final touches to the side entry area near the sacristy and the loft railings will be wrapping up as well.

Over the past week, an additional \$67,610.00 has been given to the Capital Campaign as new donations, and many are making payments on pledges already made. These all help us reach our goal to fund all aspects of the restoration effort, including the exterior work that is now underway on masonry and flashing.

Thank you so much! It’s great to hear from so many about their joy in our newly restored church and grounds! Your notes, cards, and emails mean a lot! It’s been a labor of Love! A LOT of labor, but with lots of Love!
