## The Pastor's Letter

Dear Family in the Lord,

As we live these days of the Easter Season, we realize that the resurrection cannot be limited to an historical fact, to an event that happened to Jesus almost 2000 years ago. It is a present reality, for He *is*, not simply *has*, risen! Resurrection must take place here and now in the life of every Christian. We never know the fullness of life until we live it in the footsteps of Jesus, with the life of Jesus within us. This is not something we achieve overnight, but is a gradual transformation that takes place more fully within us as we turn away from deeds of darkness and live for God. Gradually, we come to view the world and its ways not with our own eyes, but with a Christlike gaze.

The Gospel tells us how Jesus opened the minds of the disciples to the understanding of the scriptures. He explained why He had to suffer and rise from the dead on the third day. Moreover, they were to be His witnesses, preaching penance for the remission of sins, to all nations. Today, our prayer is an invitation to Jesus to come into our lives so that our minds and hearts may be opened to let in God's Word. It's our turn, as authentic disciples, and as many parts of the one body of Christ—the Church—to be witnesses to the Gospel and manifest the resurrection in our lives. The first disciples could not keep the Good News to themselves, even when its proclamation could bring them persecution or hardship. They hurried to share the truth, the good news of great promise, to all who would listen. Likewise, our relationship with Jesus, as baptized believers, requires us to communicate the Good News by attitudes, values, and lifestyle. The Christian message is never fully ours until we have shared it with others. It's not about half-hearted living, a cross-less Christianity, or an “under the radar” approach that keeps us comfortable.

Drawing closer to Christ, as we seek to do through these Easter days, means we bring Him closer to others. The message given by the angel at the empty tomb rings out for us as we approach the liturgy and scripture of these days—“come and see, go and tell”! Then, carrying the life of the Risen One within us through communion, we seek to be of one mind, one heart with Him. The Risen Lord can impact the world if our words and actions combine to reveal his power at work among those who believe! May our zeal be renewed, our hope rekindled, and our energy be kicked up a few notches as we seek to share the light of Christ with all who often walk in shadows or darkness.

We remind you that our center church door is open every day for you from 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM. In addition, the Blessed Sacrament is exposed for adoration opportunity from 7:00 to 7:55 AM Monday through Saturday, prior to Daily Mass. Each Wednesday we observe our Parish Adoration Day with Exposition from 8:30 AM to 6:00 PM. What a wonderful opportunity to step away, come before His Real Presence, and rest in Him! It was good to welcome Deacon Joseph and Deacon Bobby among us during the recent Easter Octave days. They are now wrapping up their studies at the Seminary. Deacon Joseph had his comprehensive exams for the Pontifical Masters Degree last Friday, and Deacon Bobby has his tomorrow, the 19th. They will be at the Seminary until leaving for their Ordination Retreat the week of May 10th, then return for final preparations and Ordination.

Deacon Bobby will be ordained for the Archdiocese of Boston on May 22 and offer his Mass of Thanksgiving the following day at St. Paul Parish in Cambridge, MA where he has been assigned and is in residence. Deacon Joseph will be ordained for our Diocese on June 5th and then offer his Mass of Thanksgiving here in our church at 2:00 PM on Sunday the 6th, the Solemnity of Corpus Christi. Father Joseph will also preside at Solemn Vespers and an outdoor Eucharistic Procession for the Feast later that day, at 6:00 PM. More details coming!

## Restoration & Repurposing Update

In the coming days, work will be underway installing the sprinkler system and finishing lawns, and then the landscaping will be undertaken with numerous plantings of trees, shrubs, and flowers. A statue of the Sacred Heart, with welcoming arms extended, will be located on the side of Vianney House near to the entry of the new parking area. The parking lots will be receiving the second coating of asphalt and all finishing will be taking place in coming days this month as well.

Work will be underway on the crosses that top the bell tower and facade of the church as well. The installation of the new furnace is slated for May. Work on the flashing and masonry on the facade of the church building will begin by mid-June and continue at various points, as well as interior work in the tower, through summer.

We are so grateful to those who had not yet been able to contribute toward the Restoration/Repurposing and who have recently made pledges or one-time gifts to the Capital Campaign. As you can see from a report elsewhere in this bulletin, we are drawing very close to the 2.5M goal to be able to fully fund, without any loans, all the work that remains to be completed. Thanks to all who have invested what they could!
