This half-hour devotion is a wonderful opportunity to deepen our devotion to the gift of Jesus from the Cross: His mother



to be our mother!

We will use this opportunity to commend our deacons, drawing near to priestly ordination, to her maternal embrace as well.

The Pastor's Letter

Dear Family in the Lord,

On this Sunday between the 40th day of Easter, the Ascension of our Lord, celebrated last Thursday, and the 50th day, the Solemnity of Pentecost next Sunday, the Gospel (John 17:11-19) offers us the parting words of Jesus on the night of the Last Supper. These words are meant for us just as much as they were for His apostles. We have been taken into this prayer of Jesus, as He has chosen us, the baptized, to share in His work and make even the smallest of our actions of compassion important. Our calling is to be missionaries where we are, dedicated to the truth of God's word, by the way we live and by our behavior. It's not easy to walk the talk. It's why the Lord poured forth His Spirit, with seven-fold gifts, to bolster us for the mission. We rejoice in this great gift as we remember Pentecost and open ourselves more fully to these gifts, sealed in each of us at our Confirmation.

The Gospel ends with a prayerful appeal to remain true to our Christian roots—to be consecrated to the truth. This means that we are to have a value system, not dictated by the prevailing spirit of the age or the trends of society, but based on the Gospel message, and faithful to Jesus—who is Truth—"the same yesterday, today, and forever." In this way, we stay focused on what is our true importance, what endures.

When sufferings, struggles, conflicts, and tragedies of life occur, as they inevitably do, we will remain on course, able to work through the situation, grounded in our belief that "the fruit of faithfulness is a unity and a freedom that the world cannot give."

Through the proclamation of the Gospel, the witness of their lives, and sharing the gifts of the Sacraments, our priests indeed are consecrated to the Truth in an extraordinary way. Their fidelity and example, and joy in responding to this call to live united to Christ in all things, is what can spur us all forward and inspire us to live out our baptismal call more fully and faithfully.

As we live these last days of the Easter Season, let's be united in our prayer for our own—for Deacon Bobby LeBlanc, to be ordained a Priest next Saturday, and for Deacon Joseph Moynahan, to be ordained a Priest on June 5th. They give us reason to have hope and, in cooperating with grace at work in their lives, have responded faithfully to the Lord's call through these past six years of formation, and in their own personal lives as men of integrity, authenticity, and ever-deepening unity with Christ.

As we move toward Pentecost, we ask that the sevenfold gifts of the Holy Spirit—wisdom, understanding, knowledge, counsel, fortitude, piety, and fear of the Lord—be stirred up in all of us and, in a special way within them. These were the gifts sealed in our Confirmation! It is the Holy Spirit who will be poured forth upon them in the coming days that they may use these gifts as shepherds for us all and, as Jesus quoted Isaiah at the start of His public ministry, so they can proclaim with grateful and ready hearts: "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me because He has anointed me and sent me."



Truly days of rejoicing, gratitude, and renewed hope!

NEW! Parish Scholarships



Patronal Feast Weeklong Celebration June 5 to 12



This year our Parish Patronal Feast—the Solemnity of Corpus Christi—takes on an extra special significance as we celebrate the gift of Jesus in the Holy Eucharist and in the gift of the Sacrament of Holy Orders!

Our native son, Joseph Moynahan, will be ordained on the 5th of June and celebrate his First Solemn Mass of Thanksgiving here at 2:00 PM on **Sunday, June 6th**. Later, at 6:00 PM, he will preside at Solemn Vespers (Evening Prayer) and then carry the Monstrance in our outdoor Procession, concluding with Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament.

We will observe a special Week of Parish Devotion as we observe “Forty Hours” Adoration Monday through Thursday—10 hours per day between 8AM Mass and 7PM Mass. Special reflections will be offered at the evening Masses throughout those days to deepen our appreciation for the great gift of the Priesthood, and the fruit of the Priesthood, the Most Holy Eucharist. **(June 7-10)**

On **Friday, June 11**, we will celebrate the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. A Solemn Mass will be offered at 7:00 PM, celebrated “ad orientem” at the High Altar of our church, as we do at the Advent Rorate Masses. Litany and Acts of Consecration and Reparation will be included in the evening.

Finally, to conclude the weeklong celebration, we will have a Solemn Mass at 10:00 AM on **Saturday, June 12**, the Feast of the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

Save the dates! Plan to join us now! Watch for more details coming and an opportunity to sign up to be a “scheduled adorer” for one of the 40 hours. We have been blest abundantly as a parish in these past years, we have a renewed appreciation for the Most Blessed Sacrament, and we have special reason to rejoice in the gift of the Priesthood with the Ordinations of our brothers in these days. Plan to be part of the lifting up of our hearts and voices in praise and thanksgiving and be renewed in your appreciation for these awesome gifts of our Catholic faith!




Memorial Day Mass

Looking ahead, we remind you to save **Monday, May 31st**, at **9:00 AM** to join us at Immaculate Conception Church for the annual Mass offered for all those who are interred in our Calvary Cemetery and in the older St. Mary Cemetery. It's a beautiful way to start your day, lift up our departed to the mercy of God, and remember those who gave their lives in the cause of freedom and peace.

Please note:

- The Mass will be celebrated in the church, NOT at the cemetery.
- There will be NO 8:00 AM Mass that day.



- Flowers and urns on extended bases of monuments are allowed during the summer months.
- Other floral arrangements may be placed at graves up to two weeks before and may remain for two weeks after Memorial Day.
- A “carry in/carry out” policy should be observed.
- Only veterans’ organizations may place flags on veterans’ graves; no other flags/banners are authorized.
- Seasonal displays not removed within two weeks after Memorial Day will be disposed of.


