


# The Pastor's Letter

Dear Family in the Lord,

What tremendous days of grace and blessings these have been as we brought the Easter Season to a close, celebrated Holy Pentecost, and now celebrate our sharing in the life of God—Father, Son and Holy Spirit—and move toward our Parish Patronal Feast next weekend! We have been richly blest in so many ways! My heart is overflowing with gratitude to God and to so many of you who are joyfully doing so much, often unseen by most, sharing your time and talent, in all the details that go into the celebrations of these days!

We began on Friday, May 21st, with celebrating the Confirmation and First Communion of a great group of our children as we welcomed our Bishop among us. The Ordination of now Father Bobby LeBlanc followed by his First Mass on Pentecost, and his Mass of Thanksgiving among us on May 27th were all wonderful reasons to be thankful and filled with hope!

At the end of this week, on Saturday, our native son Joseph Moynahan will be ordained a Priest for service here in our Diocese of Manchester by Bishop Libasci. We have had the grace of “up close” following and prayerfully supporting him as he discerned his call, while still working as a nurse and residing at our “Nazareth House” for a year. We celebrated his “Sending” in August of 2015 when he started Seminary, and have been graced to have him residing here in our Vianney House and sharing in our parish life whenever he has been free in these years of formation. What a blessing that, in God’s providence, Father Joseph will celebrate his First Mass, here in the church where he was baptized, next Sunday on our Patronal Feast—the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ—Corpus Christi!



You will note, as announced elsewhere in this bulletin, that we will observe a very special week of Parish Devotion and Thanksgiving from June 7 to 12 in celebration of the great gift of the Holy Eucharist and the gift of the Priesthood, which provides it! I sincerely hope EVERYONE will drop in at some point, even if just for a few minutes of adoration, with the 40 Hours Adoration opportunity being held out.

If possible, join us for special evening Masses that will mark the week and the special celebrations of the Feasts of the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary. All details are in today’s bulletin. Invite friends!

We have been celebrating over the past years many aspects of parish life that can truly fill us with a sense that we are indeed embracing a future full of hope! These days of Ordination certainly underscore this great theme once again! There are many other reason for our hope, and it is my intention over the Summer months to explore those with you in these letters.

For today, let us be a people of praise! Let’s unite in celebration and plan to be part of the weeklong opportunity to offer thanks and praise as the united Catholic Community here in Portsmouth!

**Next Saturday**, Deacon Joseph Moynahan will be Ordained to the Priesthood of Jesus Christ at 10:00AM in St. Joseph Cathedral in Manchester! Live streaming of the Ordination will be available on the website of the Cathedral. We encourage all to be united in prayer, even though in person attendance is limited, and to watch if possible.

**Next Sunday**, the newly ordained Father Joseph will celebrate his First Solemn Mass of Thanksgiving here in our Parish Church at 2:00 PM on our patronal feast day, the Solemnity of Corpus Christi! All are invited to join us. A prelude of Sacred Music and Anthems will begin at 1:30 PM.

**Next Sunday evening at 6:00 PM**, we will conclude the day with Solemn Vespers (Evening Prayer), an Outdoor Procession, and Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament, led by Father Joseph.

**Food & Fellowship Gathering** will take place next Sunday from 3:30 to 5:30 PM in our Parish Center on Woodbury Ave. We invite you to drop in to enjoy time together and congratulate our newly ordained Father Joseph. The installation of the sprinkler system and drainage beds, and plantings of trees, shrubs and perennial plants and ground cover have all occurred over the past two weeks. The second coat of asphalt paving, followed by striping, in both parking lots, will occur this week with paving early in the week and striping next Saturday morning. (Please note that the lots may be temporarily closed to use for a few hours on these days.) Good to hear from so many of you, and our neighbors, of appreciation for this effort! A few more finishing touches are coming—watch for more! We will then begin the masonry and restoration work on the facade of the church building in mid-June. Thanks to all who hadn't contributed initially, but have recently been offering pledges/donations to our Capital Campaign funding of all these aspects of the Restoration. ### *Patronal Feast* *Weeklong Celebration* *June 5 to 12*

This year our Parish Patronal Feast—the Solemnity of Corpus Christi—takes on an extra special significance as we celebrate the gift of Jesus in the Holy Eucharist and in the gift of the Sacrament of Holy Orders!



Our native son, Joseph Moynahan, will be ordained on the 5th of June and celebrate his First Solemn Mass of Thanksgiving here at 2:00 PM on **Sunday, June 6th**. Later, at 6:00 PM, he will preside at Solemn Vespers (Evening Prayer) and then carry the Monstrance in our outdoor Procession, concluding with Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament.

We will observe a special Week of Parish Devotion as we observe "Forty Hours" Adoration Monday through Thursday—10 hours per day between 8AM Mass and 7PM Mass. Special reflections will be offered at the evening Masses throughout those days to deepen our appreciation for the great gift of the Priesthood, and the fruit of the Priesthood, the Most Holy Eucharist. (**June 7-10**)

On **Friday, June 11**, we will celebrate the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. A Solemn Mass will be offered at 7:00 PM, celebrated "ad orientem" at the High Altar of our church, as we do at the Advent Rorate Masses. Litany and Acts of Consecration and Reparation will be included in the evening. Finally, to conclude the weeklong celebration, we will have a Solemn Mass at 10:00 AM on **Saturday, June 12**, the Feast of the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

Save the dates! Plan to join us now! Watch for more details coming and an opportunity to sign up to be a "scheduled adorer" for one of the 40 hours. We have been blest abundantly as a parish in these past years, we have a renewed appreciation for the Most Blessed Sacrament, and we have special reason to rejoice in the gift of the Priesthood with the Ordinations of our brothers in these days. 
Hear Cappella Nova Mundi sing choral works not heard in 500 years! The New England-based Chamber Choir Cappella Nova Mundi (CNM) will hold an open rehearsal at Immaculate Conception Church on **Saturday, June 12th**, from 6:30 to 8:30 PM. Admission is free.

All of the music featured at this event will be by Franco-Flemish Renaissance composer Pierre de la Rue (c.1452—1518), and it is unlikely that any of the featured works will have been heard anywhere for half a millennium. CNM's conductor, William Kempster, has recently finalized a complete edition of la Rue's works running to nearly 2,700 pages, and six of these pieces—none of which have seemingly been performed since the 16th century—have been chosen as repertoire for this unique event. This open rehearsal is the first stage in a project that will hopefully culminate in World Premiere recordings of this music to be released by CNM sometime in 2022.

Choral ensembles all over the world have been hit particularly hard by COVID-19, and the members of CNM have not sung together since September, 2019. The group is excited, therefore, not only to get together again after such a long time, but also to share that experience with anyone who might be interested!


