The Pastor's Letter

Dear Family in the Lord,

In these days of Spring into Summer, we certainly see the awakening of so much around us! The budding of trees has given way to full blossoms. New sprouts can be seen all over, and flowers, shrubs, and bushes are all showing signs of life stirring. Close to home, it's especially emphasized this season with the beautiful landscaping touches that have been added to the "holy ground" surrounding our church and rectory, as the "repurposing" of our grounds reaches completion. We know that as time passes, growth will be obvious, ground cover plantings will expand, and watering—whether by nature or the new irrigation system—will support and enhance that growth, rather than have all wither and die.

The scriptures this weekend have us look at growth—our spiritual growth—in terms of this beauty of nature. They remind us of the smallest, and seemingly insignificant seed—planted, nurtured, watered—that, with patience and endurance, will grow in amazing ways!

Many families see it in their children as a school year concludes. If their parental investment took place in terms of nurturing seeds of faith, and supporting the development of body, mind, and soul, parents are often amazed at the growth and wonder at it all. I've seen it and rejoice in it in many of our young people who, obviously, are growing in age, wisdom, and grace! I'm happy to have a part in this "growing," and am so inspired by the "fertile soil" that so many of our family homes are offering!

And, of course, I still find myself marveling and giving thanks for all the growth we have seen over the years, and have celebrated over these past few weeks, in the Ordination to the Priesthood of our two parishioners, now Father Bobby LeBlanc and Father Joseph Moynahan! What a blessing to celebrate the seeds planted in their families and homes, the nurturing, pruning, and persevering care that has gone into the process of these past years as the seed of vocation, planted in them by the Lord, has been cared for lovingly by so many in this parish. Through years of formation, ministry experiences, personal growth in prayer, spiritual direction, sharing fraternity, and their trust, endurance, and perseverance, we have had the joy of seeing the blossoming of these priestly vocations. We certainly have much to be thankful for and proud of! I'm so grateful to all of you who took the time to join with our parish family last week in our week of Thanks and Adoration—our 40 Hours Devotion and the beautiful Liturgies of that week!

Personally, I am using this time to look back and be thankful for all the "seed planters" and "gardeners" the Lord has blessed me with in my life, in my vocation discernment, formation, and these past 36 years of priestly ministry. I invite you to do the same "look back" in your walk with the Lord and in your vocation. It's amazing to see how the Lord blesses us: waters us with grace, strengthens us with the Sacraments, prunes us, tends us, affirms us, and keeps us growing. If we open ourselves fully, we will not wither and die for lack of roots, moisture, nutrients, light, or TLC. I think the more we are conscious of how we have received this care, the more we feel compelled to be the gardener's assistant in the lives we touch.

It's been a blessing for me to have known Father Joseph and Father Bobby for close to ten years! It's been a grace to have been able to do some planting, weeding, tending, watering, and nurturing in these years leading up to their embrace of the Priesthood. It's been a blessing for me to see the growth God has worked in my life, through them and through so many of you, in your personal support, prayer, and care for me over these years, and in the great aid to growth your example has been which has inspired me more than you realize!

All ages, all different stages of growth—all recipients of the seed He plants in His Word, His Church, and in the support we give each other as we walk the walk. Let's let today's scripture, and the events of these days, and looking back at our own lives, lead us to cooperate fully with grace and experience continued growth beyond our imaginings! After all, don't forget the potential of the mustard seed well planted and received!

Eagle Scout Project Update

Dear Corpus Christi Parishioners,
Here is the latest on my "Stations of the Cross—Walk" Eagle Project: Over the past six months, most of the work has been focused on clearing the area behind the Parish Center. To date, we have had 30 volunteers, providing over 60 hours of labor, clearing 27 trailer loads of overgrowth to the dump. The next step will be installing the walkway. I am planning on using a small bobcat to dig the path, then installing edging and stone. If you have a small bobcat, or heavy equipment we could utilize, please email me. After that we will install the posts to hold the stations. My goal is to finish this project in July. Originally we were going to use volunteers to build stations, but for practical reasons that has changed. Look for future announcements, or reach out to me if you are interested in volunteering during the remaining stages of the project. Thank you for all your support!


