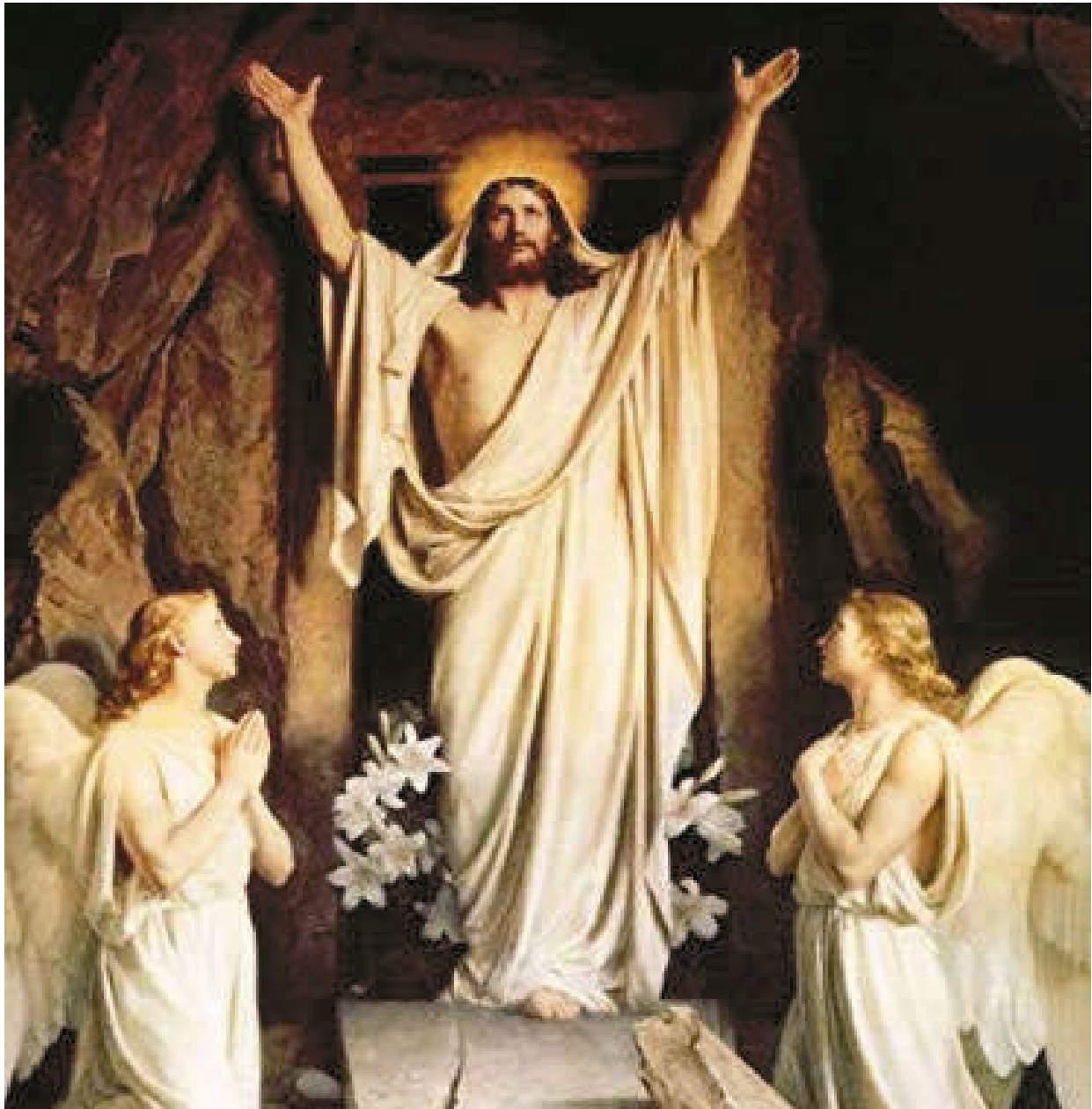

The Pastor's Easter Message

Dear Family in the Lord,

As the Paschal Candle was carried into the darkened church at the great Easter vigil, kindling the candles in the hands of all gathered, a tangible sign illuminated the darkness and we were reminded that His victory we celebrate in Easter triumph is our victory! The light He came to bring to shatter the darkness of sin and death, the light bursting forth as He bursts forth from the tomb, is passed on to us at our Baptism. Throughout all the diverse opportunities of our daily living, we are to be the bearers of that light that brings hope and illuminates the Truth, who is Jesus Himself! What we begin today, we will celebrate for the next fifty days of the glorious Easter Season! We will continue to unwrap this great mystery and see how this great paschal mystery is not something “remembered,” but rather embraced and lived by all of us, diverse parts of the one living Body of Christ!

In the Easter Proclamation that was sung before the Paschal Candle – once it was carried by the priest through the church, stopping in the three places the cross stopped the day before – these words rang out: “This is the night when Christ broke the prison bars of death and rose victorious from the underworld. Our birth would have been no gain, had we not been redeemed.” What a powerful reminder of what life is really all about! The proclamation went on to proclaim to our Heavenly Father: “O wonder of Your humble care for us! O love, O charity beyond all telling, to ransom a slave you gave away your Son! O truly necessary sin of Adam, destroyed completely by the death of Christ! O happy fault that earned so great, so glorious a Redeemer!”



That says it all, friends! While “Happy Easter” might be a greeting for today, to truly grasp the happiness and hope of Easter, we need to ponder these realities! We’re not looking back at the fact that Jesus rose, but need to also open our eyes and hearts to more fully perceive that He IS risen, alive within and among us – guiding, directing, illuminating – and asking us to share in that mission. As the angel at the tomb directed the disciples when they peered into the empty tomb, so we are given the same directive: “Come and see... go and tell.” Let’s continue to stand firm in declaring where He is not, and be His witnesses who share with others where He can be found – “He goes before you...” In Word, in our sharing in His risen life with every reception of His body and blood, in every confession, when we are given that victory of rising beyond the power of death and sin in the healing words of absolution... it is indeed the happiness of Easter that fills us over and over and over again!

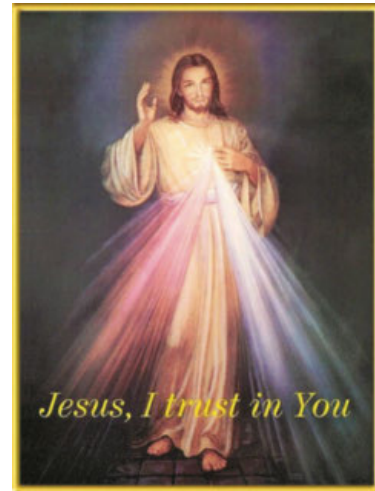

Due to an early Easter deadline, our weekly financial report was not yet available when the bulletin went to press. It will appear in next week's issue.

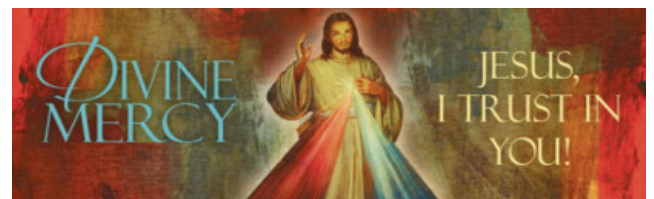
Divine Mercy Novena

Forty days of fasting leads to fifty days of feasting! From Easter day until the Sunday after, the Liturgical celebrations take on a very special tone as we observe these first eight days of the season as the Easter Octave. In the rich scriptures of the Liturgy, we enter into the wonderful events of the encounters with the Risen Lord. Since this is also the period of the Divine Mercy Novena, as noted elsewhere, and in order to make it easier for more of you to join in celebration of these festive days, we will celebrate **Holy Mass at 6:30 PM Monday through Friday, April 18—22**, in addition to the 8:00 AM Mass. Easter Evangelization: Come and See...Go and Tell!

The Gospel accounts of that early Easter morning tell us of seekers who “came to see” the tomb where Jesus was buried. They found it empty and were asked why they were seeking the Living One among the dead! The messenger proclaimed Him to be alive and gone ahead of them into Galilee. They were to “go and tell” the others that He was alive! Trusting, gathered together as disciples, they then experienced the Risen One coming to them and, in the words of sacred Scripture, “showing them in many convincing ways that He was alive!” In the first of His post resurrection appearances, on the evening of the day, He gives them the gift of his Divine Mercy. Then, in many ways: around a fire, in opening up the scriptures, walking on the way, in their frustrations and fears, in the midst of their work, in sharing food, and ultimately in inviting them to be heralds of His Risen Life, Christ forms His disciples to “go and make disciples!”

This is the heart and message of evangelization! It’s the call of every baptized person who has the life of the Risen One within! It is about the continual invitation to come and see—to discover where Jesus is not and where He can be found, the seeking not among the dead, in darkness, sin, and secularism, but where He dwells among us in Word, Sacrament, and in our very souls bathed in grace! Those who enter this encounter, who discover Him, let Him form them deeply in His life and love, as Jesus did with His disciples from the time of resurrection until the ascension—when He entrusted His mission to His disciples—His Church—them and us! And, He empowered them in the outpouring of the Spirit and continues in our times to pour out His Spirit upon us in Confirmation and stir it up in us that we might fan the flame of faith in the lukewarm and ignite the fire of faith in those who are in darkness! The liturgy and scriptures of the coming fifty days of Easter Season remind us of how He formed them then, and how He forms us now, that we might help form, renew and ignite others.

At the start of Lent, we announced the launching of a renewed effort at Evangelization in our parish that will seek to reach all—of all ages and stages of life—with the Good News that Jesus wants us not simply to know about Him, but to know Him, to have relationship with Him, and then to share the fruitfulness of that with others, individually and as a community of faith. So much is needed in our godless secular culture. So much needs healing in a broken fractured world. Among so many opinions, we need TRUTH. Instead of escapes and detours around challenges, we need the WAY, and, never settling for getting by, settling for passing pleasures and escape instead of lasting joy and healing, we need LIFE! It is the Risen One who is the Way, the Truth, and the Life! Embracing the call of evangelization is announcing, modeling, inviting, and sharing this Good News that He is alive and lives!

In these next fifty days of Easter, before we officially launch our Evangelization Initiative: *Embracing a Future Full of Hope*, I will be working with the three people we announced would be joining our staff to spearhead these efforts, in forming an EVANGELIZATION VISIONING TEAM, comprised of various parishioners who currently embrace opportunities of evangelization in our parish. Together with them, we will dream dreams, put forth hopes, and begin to develop a strategy to launch these efforts as we conclude the Easter Season with a Novena to the Holy Spirit and a Commissioning (sending forth) on Pentecost—the 50th day of Easter! As Jesus used these days to form those who would be sent forth, so we will do. In coming weeks, we will seek unified prayerful support as we invoke “Our Lady of the New Evangelization” during the month of May, that we might carry Christ, hold Him up, and say “Yes” to all God asks of us as she did, and as Mary was in the midst of the Church at that first Pentecost, as the Holy Spirit was poured forth, so we will seek to unite our prayers with hers as we invoke the same Spirit: Come Holy Spirit! Renew us, that we might help renew the face of the earth!

Hold this in prayer as we enter this season. Watch for more. And, once again, we warmly welcome and thank the three who will be joining our pastoral staff and working with me in bringing this vision forward: Dominic Paradis, as Director of Evangelization & Outreach; Lisa Bald, as Director of Families of Faith; and Tom Miller as Director of Youth Ministry. We have great reason to rejoice in hope!

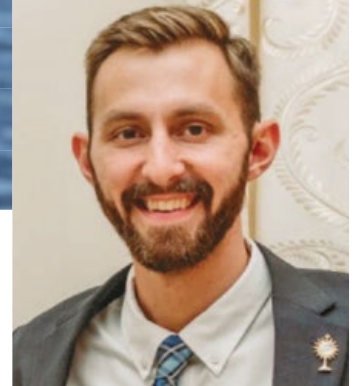

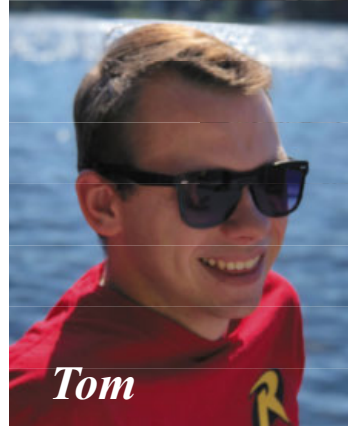

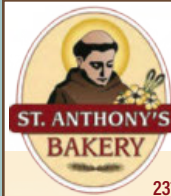
