A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR



Dear Brothers & Sisters in Christ,

OUR COMING ALPHA PROGRAM: I hope you enjoyed viewing the two short videos we aired in the church last weekend to reintroduce Alpha to everyone. It piqued the interest of a number of people. In fact, several parishioners who asked questions after Mass made the decision to sign up.

This weekend we will have the opportunity to listen to the experience of several of those who participated in the fall. In all, there were 46 people with about 15 team members who ran the program. It was a positive experience for everyone who attended. I thought that it would be invaluable to hear of their experience and hopefully, this will be the catalyst to inspire you to participate as well.

The beginning of this Alpha Program coincides with the Sacred Season of Lent, a special time of serious reflection and the further building of the faith community of St. James. I hope that you will choose to join us at Alpha.

LENTEN PARISH MISSION: It is important that we are reminded each year of the spiritual purpose of the Sacred Season of Lent. At the conclusion of Lent, we will enter Holy Week and the celebration of the Triduum: Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter, recalling the passion, death and resurrection of Jesus. The celebration of the passion, death and resurrection are known as the Paschal Mystery. At our baptism we became participators in this mystery. It is appropriate to renew our baptismal vows at Easter.

PREPARING FOR THE RENEWING OF OUR BAPTISMAL PROMISES:

Our Parish Mission will help us to prepare ourselves for this most important event. It will run on Monday evenings during Lent from 7:30 – 8:30 PM, and will include a period of Eucharistic Adoration and conclude with Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament.

FIRST FRIDAY DEVOTION: For the last several months we have held a special Mass on the First Friday of the month at 7:30 PM which included a period of Eucharistic Adoration and the opportunity to go to Confession. Starting in March, our First Friday Devotion is being moved to a new time, after the regularly scheduled daily 12:10 PM Mass. We believe this change in scheduling will enable more people to participate. We hope that you will join us.




